Thank you for your letter of April 23, 1991 requesting information on the ports of call of the tank barges in our fleet.

Among other things, you requested that we verify the information provided on the ADEC memorandum, especially information on vessel "gross-weight tonnage". We are not familiar with that term, vessel sizes are normally given in gross registered tons, as indicated on the ADEC memo. The GRTs for the various barges listed by ADEC are correct, except for the barge FOSS 256 which is 2,650 GRT as opposed to the 2,656 listed in the memo and the FOSS 255 which is 2,654 GRT as opposed to the 2,637 listed in the memo. Further, two of the barges, the FOSS TONGASS and the PHOENIX 120 are no longer in service in Alaska.

You also requested information on the ports of call of each of the identified vessels. The barges FOSS 256 and FOSS 255 call at the following ports or places: Juneau, Dillingham, King Cove, Cordova, Naknek, Sand Point, Valdez, Dutch Harbor, Chignik, Anchorage, Nome, Port Moller, Kenai, Homer, Akutan, Kodiak and Cold Bay. The barge SEA 76 calls at the following ports or places: Haines, Petersburg, Juneau, Wrangle, Hoonah, Ketchikan and Sitka. The FOSS ENERGIZER is used as an oil spill response vessel in Valdez. The HANAIEI calls at the following ports or places: Dutch Harbor, Dillingham and Naknek.

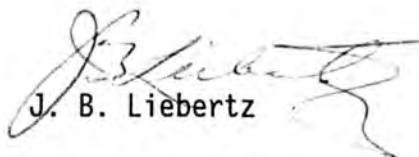

Received your letter of April 23rd, regarding oil barge regulations, etc..

Yes, we do have an oil barge, "King Salmon"--979 tons--10,000 barrel.

Pollution insurance is maintained according to Alaska State law.

We have a processing facility near Emmonak, in the Yukon, established in 1966. We hauled our own fuel for many years and bought what we couldn't haul at False Pass and St. Michael. In 1987, we purchased a tug and barge to haul our fuel, freight and frozen fish, not only for ourselves, but also Yukon Delta, of Emmonak. At the time, they were left without any transportation.

We take fuel from Seattle, on the way North, and get fuel at Dutch Harbor during the summer. We supply Yukon Delta, the Emmonak Tank Farm, and, of course, all our fishermen and our own needs, plus anyone else who may need fuel in the general area.

I certainly hope we do not get in the same class as the super tankers. From your letter, I believe you are on the right track. So far, the DEC has some pretty stiff rules suggested, which can either drive us out of business or raise the price of fuel in these areas considerably, to cover costs of abiding by them. This fuel and supplies are vital at Spring breakup--not only to us but to others we supply.

I sincerely hope this answers your questions. Please feel free to contact me at any time on this issue.

Dear Sir or Madame:

This session I introduced legislation in the Senate that will enable Alaska to join the Pacific Ocean Resources Compact. The Compact as currently proposed will have three members from each of the states of Alaska, California, Hawaii, Oregon, and Washington. Similar legislation was introduced in these states. The compact agency will have authority to regulate activities related to oil and hazardous substances within the compact zone. The compact zone extends from the oceans bordering the party states to the 200-mile exclusive economic zone.

Under Article II of the proposed compact, the definition of vessel is intended to exempt smaller barges transporting non-crude petroleum products to communities. However, the current compact language is not clear. Our intent is to clarify the language in the committee process to exempt barges under 5,000 gross-weight tonnage.

To facilitate this process, we would like information on the ports of call of the barge vessels in your fleet. Attached is an Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation memorandum on barges operating in Alaska. I would appreciate if for your company you would 1) verify the information provided, especially information on vessel gross-weight tonnage; 2) provide information on the ports of call of each of the identified vessels; and 3) add any omitted information.

Senate Bill 102 is currently in the Senate Special Committee on Oil and Gas; additional hearings are expected to be scheduled in the near future. If you have any questions, please contact me or Ginny Fay on my staff at (907)465-3711 or FAX (907)465-4979.

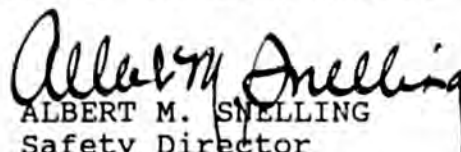
Tank Barge Annahootz, Official Number 655941, 2,638 gross tons is operated by Samson Tug and Barge Company, P.O. Box 559, Sitka, Alaska 99835.

The T/B Annahootz is inspected and certificated under Subchapter D of 46 CFR by the U.S. Coast Guard; certified for ocean service. It is also required to meet the requirements of Subchapter O of 33 CFR - Pollution. In addition to carrying 37,000 plus barrel of non-persistent petroleum products (gasoline, diesel oil, and aviation fuel) the above deck cargo consist of containerized freight. Cargo consisting of boats, building supplies, modular homes and groceries may be carried.

The ports of Sitka, Juneau, Haines, and Ketchikan, in Southeast Alaska are the normal ports for the transportation of petroleum products. However, contracts for delivery to other ports in Alaska are possible and have occurred. With a Certificate of Inspection for ocean service, we are not prohibited from transporting cargo on the high seas or to any port in Alaska.

The containerized cargo may be assigned to ports of call, such as Seward, Valdez, Kodiak, King Salmon, Dutch Harbor, and Adak, as well as others. Also cargo may be shipped to Seattle from these ports. Samson Tug and Barge Company provides a year round, every two week sailing schedule from the port of Seattle, Washington to ports in Alaska.

Dear Senator Eliason:

A marine industry organization from Anchorage advised us on Friday May 26, 1991, of Senate Bill 263, which had been introduced, was in committee, and that testimony was being received on that afternoon. This bill would amend a portion of HB 567 of 1990. It would offer some relief from the regulations that go into effect on 1 June 1991; extending portions of the regs until 1992. We have submitted written comment on this bill to the Oil and Gas Committee. We invite you to review the bill and encourage its passage.

Senate Bill 263 would allow time to study and analyze non-crude operations, including facility operations, transportation of and the economic effects. The operational and engineering standards, established by the state in HB 567, we consider to be unworkable and as a result petroleum transportation operations by our company will be discontinued on June 1, 1991. Operating under the interim approved contingency plan we now have, plus amendments that must be made, we feel cannot be done legally. The opposite of course being illegal, which subjects Samson Tug and Barge to civil penalties, lawsuits, and possible criminal action. We have been advised that other transportation companies are considering this same avenue.

As our State Senator, we would request that you keep us up to date on the outcome of this bill and future bills concerning the transportation of petroleum products.
