THROUGH ROYALTY AND TAXES. IT IS THUS UNFAIR AND UNNECESSARY TO CREATE SPECIAL AND DISCRIMINATORY TAXES ON THE TRANS ALASKA PIPELINE SYSTEM. SINCE IT WILL BE ONE OF THE MAJOR ECONOMIC UNITS IN ALASKA AND WILL EMPLOY PROPERTY OF GREAT VALUE, IT IS INEVITABLE THAT ANY FAIR, EQUITABLE AND FAR-SIGHTED TAX PROGRAM WILL DERIVE A MAJOR PORTION OF ITS REVENUE FROM THE PIPELINE.

IN CONCLUSION, I WOULD EMPHASIZE THAT WE REQUEST NO EXEMPTIONS WHATEVER FROM ANY TAXATION, BUT ONLY THAT WE BE SPARED THE BURDEN OF SPECIAL AND DISCRIMINATORY TAXATION. WE BELIEVE THAT THIS BILL IS DISCRIMINATORY, UNFAIR, PREMATURE AND THAT IT SHOULD NOT BE CONSIDERED FURTHER AT THIS TIME. WE BELIEVE THAT ANY TAXATION OF THE TRANS ALASKA PIPELINE SYSTEM SHOULD BE CONSIDERED AS PART OF AND COORDINATED WITH A LONG-TERM TAX PROGRAM OF THE STATE AS IT APPLIES NOT ONLY TO TRANSPORTATION OF OIL AND GAS BUT TO OTHER ECONOMIC ACTIVITY AS WELL. WHEN CONSIDERED IN THAT CONTEXT, WE ARE CONFIDENT THAT THIS AND FUTURE ALASKAN LEGISLATURES WILL TAX THE TRANS ALASKA PIPELINE SYSTEM AS AN INTEGRAL PART OF A COORDINATED PROGRAM OF TAXATION WHICH WILL NOT SINGLE OUT ANY ACTIVITY OR INDUSTRY TO BEAR A DISCRIMINATORY OR DISPROPORTIONATE SHARE OF THE TAX BURDEN OF THE STATE.



Passage of HB 101 will raise the commission due a license officer for sale of Fish and Game licenses (both Sport Fish and Commercial Fishing) from the present 5% to 10%. The above will not result in an increase in budget cost but rather a decrease in the amount of revenue received.

Effect on Treasury

Based on the 1972 Calender Year Sales approximately \$111,500 less per year would accrue to the state from license sales if the commission is increased.

Problems of Administration

1. HB 101 does not provide for an effective date. Each license officer is required to report sales on a monthly basis and any change in commission rate should be effective on the 1st day of the month. I would recommend an effective date of 1/1/74.
2. HB 101 reduces the commission to those vendors who only sell the 25¢ license. We have 92 vendors with sales made up wholly of 25¢ licenses or at least the majority of their sales are 25¢ licenses. These vendors presently keep the 25¢ license fee as their commission. Under this bill they would get a commission of 2.5¢ per license on these sales.

I feel that the above will result in the loss of many of the vendors in the bush areas of the state and as a result many residents of Alaska will be unable to secure the licenses they need to hunt, fish and trap legally.

Dear Miss Spragg:

I have noticed Senate Bill No. 77 and House Bill No. 135, which appear to be identical and which appear to have a good chance of passage, in view of the number of sponsors in each house.

Before final passage of either of these bills, I believe that two minor corrections should be made in them and I have a question concerning them.

1. In section 2, on line 27 of page 1, I suggest that "the proceeds" be changed to "such uses." In other words, the proceeds do not "include" any projects and are not "limited to" any projects. It is the uses of those proceeds which should include, or be limited to, particular projects.

2. In the proposition in section 4, on lines 17 and 18 on page 2, I suggest that "projects for" be inserted between "rehabilitation" and "recreational" and that "projects" be deleted after "fisheries" and before the question mark. This will conform the description of purpose in the proposition with that in section 1 and in the title of the bill, and it will also improve what is now a very awkward series of words ("production and rehabilitation recreational and commercial fisheries projects").

3. As you know, general obligation bonds can be issued only for capital improvements. I assume that the production and rehabilitation projects to be funded are capital improvements, but I am curious as to the nature of these projects. I think that some investigation to ascertain that they are clearly capital improvements may be in order, and I also wonder why the word "funding" was used in place of the customary phrase "paying the cost of."
