Dear Mr. Burton:

I had occasion to read with interest an article published in the March 18th Anchorage Times which relates Representative Osterback's attempt to have the Fish and Wildlife Protection Division transferred from Public Safety back to Fish and Game. Although the merits of such a move are beyond my scope of competence, I was dismayed to find that a recent trial in Sand Point has been used as an example to criticize the Department of Fish and Wildlife Protection.

This trial involved fishing in closed waters, specifically the mouth of a spawning stream. The facts and the law were presented by very competent counsel both for the State and defense to a jury comprised of community members. After deliberations the jury acquitted all defendants.

Even though the defendants were acquitted, this trial should not be used as criticism of the officers involved. Let me point out that the jury saw fit to ignore the officers' testimony that they observed loaded nets being pulled through the waters and ultimately hoisted on board the boats. Due to this activity being in the late evening only the full nets were observed; not individual fish. The jury acquitted because actual fish were not identified by the protection officers. The most obvious, common sense conclusion that the nets contained fish was rejected and speculation has it that some other unknown quantity of wildlife was contained therein.

It is indeed unfortunate that the jury thought that "taking" meant actually seeing the fins of fish, especially when a further instruction could have been given which would have clearly defined this word to encompass the acts observed. I choose to believe that the jury acquitted due to an honest misunderstanding of the law. And, as trial judge, the responsibility for allowing such a situation to present itself lies squarely with me - not with the attorneys nor the state officers involved. However, let me point out that after hearing the evidence the defense attorney did not raise this issue.

Mr. Commissioner, I am confident you are aware of the sociological and community problems with prosecution of fishing violations in a small fishing community during fishing season. Even though the result was not what the prosecutor would have wished, all those participating agreed that the trial was beneficial in that the intent to prosecute violators was reaffirmed. The subtle benefit from the trial may very well be hidden within the future conduct of all fisherman.

In closing let me reaffirm my statement that this case could best serve as an example of the professionally competent investigative work product of the Fish and Wildlife Protection Division.

Dear Mr. Gardner:

Please accept this letter in answer to your question of why we were not patrolling the herring fishery in District 3.

It is with very little pleasure that I have to tell you that our primary reason was that we did not have a vessel and/or operator available.

The 19 foot Glasply that is assigned to the Craig area was and still is in Ketchikan waiting on parts to repair the outboard. And our operator that is assigned to the Ketchikan area that has the ability to run the Stenella (38 foot Bertram) was and still is, in the academy at Sitka.

To be very frank with you Mr. Gardner, we did not have any scheduled plans that included patrolling that area. For the past five years that I've been responsible for the S.E. area this year is the first time that we've been made aware of a problem in this winter fishery. Also, the emergency closures caught us a little off guard and/or unprepared, for normally all areas were open all season, but not this year.

As I understand it, you received complaints of vessels fishing in closed waters and herring being wasted.

Immediately after your telephone call I requested Sgt. Blodgett who was just assigned to Ketchikan on December 1, to investigate those complaints and this is the report that I received from him.

On 2/10/77, Officer Fuelling attended a meeting of fishermen from Craig. The meeting was called by Fred Shapley to try to close down the herring fishery in District 3. Officer Fuelling reported on what areas were already closed to herring fishing. At this time, George Shapley reported seeing a vessel in the closed area on 1/4/77 acting suspicious. He could not identify the vessel nor could he positively say the vessel was fishing, but he thought it was from Petersburg. This was the first time we had heard there was possible herring fishing in closed waters.

From 2/15/77 through 2/19/77, Officer Fuelling patrolled the closed area aboard a Department of Fish and Game vessel. No vessels were observed in the closed area. One vessel was observed in the open area of District 3.

With the permanent assignment of a 38 foot vessel at Ketchikan, it will now give us the capabilities of patrolling a winter fishery, and once the officer who will operate that vessel completes his training at the academy we will have the capability of immediately responding to complaints and working winter fisheries. Something we have not been capable of before.

I would be available to discuss this fishery or any enforcement program within S.E. with you at your convenience.

A copy of the petition from residents of Craig, Klawock, and Hydaburg regarding herring fishing in district 3 has been received through the Craig Advisory Committee. The petition will be considered by the Board of Fisheries when they meet in Juneau later this week. Through use of the Craig Fish and Game Advisory Committee, the residents of the west coast have expressed their views through the appropriate forum.

While it appears that an additional I & E effort was necessary in this case, I would point out that herring harvesting has been subjected to considerable public review throughout Southeastern in recent years. Articles have appeared in the Ketchikan Daily News, the departments' herring program has been covered in the New Alaskan, all sections of the herring regulations have been annually open for public review through the Advisory Committee and Board of Fisheries processes, and the staff has spent many hours making presentations to various public groups. The efforts may not have been totally adequate, but they have been extensive. In this regard, however, the staff will make additional effort to initiate more contact with the west coast communities.

The winter herring fishery has been open throughout Southeastern Alaska since 1970, except those areas designated for roe herring harvest. In district 3 significant harvests have taken place over the last four years. Harvests have taken place in Boca De Finas, Sea Otter Sound, and El Capitan until this year, when populations were also fished in Port Alice, Trocadero Bay, and Sea Otter Harbor.

The harvests have ranged from 820,000 pounds in 1974 to 2.3 million pounds this season. Expansion of the harvest has occurred as the result of gaining

biological information on some stocks and locating stocks in areas which have not been previously fished. A breakdown of the 76-77 herring harvest from the west coast area is as follows:

Surveys of the area were conducted by the Department vessels Kittiwake and Sundance and the National Marine Fisheries Service vessel John H. Cobb. All populations fished were not assessed due to distributional patterns of the fish within the fishing area. Substantial populations are frequently found in broken scattered schools which cannot be assessed acoustically. In these cases limited harvests of approximately 100 tons are permitted on the basis of the fishermen's assessment, if it appears the stock is large enough. The area is then closed until the department can assess and if an assessment cannot be obtained, the area is not reopened. If assessment is accomplished, the area is reopened to permit a 10-20% fishing mortality on the stock. This conservative approach has been instrumental in developing the herring fishery as the fishermen and the department work quite closely in locating stocks and begin to gain a reasonable knowledge of the health of that stock. This policy has been uniformly applied to all areas of Southeastern.

Close contact is maintained with the fishermen participating in the herring fishery by the management and research staff and it is our view that the fishery has been conducted with few, if any, violations. A relatively small number of vessels are involved in the fishery at any one time and no loads of herring were delivered that we were not confident of the source.

Emergency orders were written on five occasions establishing closures in district 3 as allowable quantities were taken in various areas. Copies of these emergency orders are sent to all Fish and Wildlife Officers in Southeastern Alaska. In Ketchikan the Fish and Wildlife Protection Office was called at the

time the emergency order was promulgated. These calls are logged in our Ketchikan office.

As previously indicated, we will make an additional effort to discuss herring management with the people on the west coast and the entire issue will have benefit of a Board review in the near future. Should you require additional information, I would be glad to furnish you with whatever may be needed.

Mr. Sharp indicated that a "stake-out" crew is vital in order to catch stream robbers. He feels that this bill, in that it would require that those attempting to catch violators remain in plain site, would make it difficult to catch many violators, and therefore would do more harm than good for the resources of Alaska. The Department of Public Safety apparently feels that the "stake-out" crew is their most effective tool.

The committee felt that they would need to receive more information before they could come to a decision on this bill. Specifically, they wanted such information as the number of fish confiscated by "stake-out" crews, number of fish caught from 1960-1975, etc, in order to get a feel for the role of the "stake-out" crew vs. the stream guards.

This bill will be considered at a later date.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 p.m.

In response to your request for information as to enforcement programs in commercial salmon fisheries during Fiscal 1976, the following is submitted.

The Alaska Department of Public Safety, Fish and Wildlife Protection enforcement programs for commercial salmon fisheries from the 1976 season beginning in May of 1976 and running through October 1976, by area.

ARCTIC/YUKON/KUSKOKWIM

Officer Henslee of McGrath was sent TDY to Bethel. One probationary Fish and Wildlife Officer, John Kinzy of Bethel, and one temporary employee, Mike Schumacher, were also assigned to this fishery, this area consisting of the lower Yukon and Kuskokwim Rivers west of the Kilbuck Mountains. Officer Henslee, flying a state-owned Cessna 180 aircraft on floats, was responsible for the placement of the two other personnel who were assigned. A 24 foot river skiff powered by a 50 H.P. Mercury outboard was used out of Bethel on the upriver and downriver patrols during open and closed fishing periods on the Kuskokwim. The entire program consisted primarily of a combination of Officer Henslee's flying the fishing areas, both alone and accompanied by one of the other Officers, or two of the Officers patrolling the Kuskokwim River out of Bethel in the river skiff. Not having a boat on the lower Yukon, no patrols were made by boat in that area. Considering that to cover this assigned area by 180 aircraft it takes five to six hours of flying, considerable flying was done to try and cover all the areas where fishing occurs.

UPPER YUKON/UPPER KUSKOKWIM/TANANA RIVERS

These fisheries were handled out of the Fairbanks, Bettles and Delta stations utilizing the seven permanent officers stationed in these posts. Patrols were made by float equipped Supercub and wheeled Supercubs stationed in Fairbanks, Delta and Bettles. Limited use of a riverboat out of Fairbanks was used in fisheries located near the road system. Patrols were almost exclusively by officers in aircraft. Since the area they must cover is equal to the size of six large states and the fisheries are located along several hundred mile stretches of these rivers, it requires long hours of flying to monitor these fisheries. In addition, the time period of the commercial fisheries coincides with heavy activity in the sport fish and game resources.

NORTON SOUND

This fishery was handled by one permanent officer out of Nome who is assigned one temporary employee during June and July. Patrols are made by the use of a twenty-one foot Boston Whaler boat powered by two eighty-five horsepower outboards. Some aircraft use was also utilized.

BRISTOL BAY (NAKNEK - KVICHAK - EGEGIK)

The Bristol Bay fishery consisted of two permanent officers stationed at King Salmon. In addition, during the peak of the fishery (June 15th through July 15th) eight permanent officers from Anchorage were assigned temporary duty to the Bristol Bay Enforcement Program alternating employees so that coverage would be guaranteed at the peak of this fishery. Patrols were made using State Supercub aircraft, one equipped with wheels and one equipped with floats. In addition, a twenty-one foot Boston Whaler equipped with a single one hundred and thirty-five horsepower outboard and a seventeen foot Boston Whaler outboard powered boat

borrowed from the Alaska Department of Fish & Game were used to patrol the waters. Early in the season the new outboard broke down causing efforts to be primarily by aircraft. An inflatable rubber boat was also used several times for running river fisheries.

BRISTOL BAY (NUSAGAK - TOGIAK - HAGMEISTER ISLAND - GOODNEWS BAY)

One permanent officer stationed at Dillingham and two temporary officers were used in this fishery with TDY permanent personnel assigned periodically throughout the fishing period. A State-owned Supercub aircraft on floats, a nineteen foot Boston Whaler outboard powered boat and a leased thirty-two foot Bristol Bay gill net-type vessel were used in this fishery. Officer Blodgett flew the aircraft and the vessel was run by the temporary officers. The leased thirty-two foot vessel towing the nineteen foot Whaler would be assigned to fishing areas and the temporaries would patrol the area in conjunction with Officer Blodgett in the aircraft. These temporary employees were also used as stream guards in the Lake Togiak silver fishery living at the cannery and patrolling the up river areas for illegal fishing.

KODIAK

This fishery is one of the more complex and varied fisheries. The large area, number of streams involved, and the type of fisheries ranging from salmon, crab and shrimp make enforcement difficult. Four permanent officers from the Kodiak post and in addition, two permanent officers stationed aboard the sixty-five foot patrol vessel "Trooper" made up the personnel assigned with this fishery for a total of six permanent officers. In addition, throughout the summer a total of nine temporary employees worked out of Kodiak during July and August. These temporary employees were used in many varied ways. From use as a stake-out crew, stream guards, boat operators, go-fors and maintenance repairmen. Patrols and enforcement activity in Kodiak varied from the use of a State Grumman Goose stationed in Kodiak, transporting men and equipment to and from temporary and permanent base camps and vessels, to the use of the sixty-five foot patrol vessel as a patrol unit and utilizing a seventeen foot Boston vessel

carried to patrol inner bays and areas while the larger patrol vessels sailed onto a point where the skiff would rendezvous with the larger patrol vessel. Also, a thirty-five foot seine boat-type vessel, which we leased from the Kodiak High School each year, was used in the same manner. Captained either by a permanent or temporary officer and accompanied by one temporary officer, they are deployed the areas where they act as a stream guard concept or as a patrol vehicle using a seventeen foot Boston Whaler to more quickly cover the area. They also move and supply stream guard or stake-out camps in their area. A twenty-five foot Bertram patrol vessel, captained either by a permanent or temporary officer, operated in its assigned area during each period either as a stream guard or a patrol unit. Also, moving and supplying other stream guards or stake-out camps. A twenty-one foot Boston Whaler outboard powered boat is used in a similar manner and as a stream guard boat for two temporary personnel who work from permanent visible camps where assigned. By working a combination of efforts utilizing the available manpower and equipment, the Detachment Commander attempts to provide coverage to the fisheries so as to protect the resource and to apprehend the serious violator while providing other public services.

SANDPOINT

One permanent officer stationed in Sandpoint and four temporary employees during July and August. In addition, an airplane pilot was hired to fly a State-owned Grumman Goose for patrol and to supply and move manpower and equipment. The sixty-five foot patrol vessel "Enforcer" manned by one permanent officer and two civilian people was also assigned to the Alaskan Peninsula this past summer. The aircraft was used as a patrol unit transporting men and equipment and supplying stream guard and stake-out camps, and the large patrol vessel, the "Enforcer," was used as a patrol unit as was its seventeen foot Boston Whaler. This unit covering the entire fisheries from False Pass to Chignik during its temporary assignment on the Alaskan Peninsula. During the peak of the salmon run it acted as a stream guard unit anchoring in prime fish areas to prevent loss of salmon escapement. The Grumman Goose aircraft and the vessel were used to transport and supply stream guard and stake-out camps as well as individual patrol units. The overall enforcement program for the Peninsula being the responsibility of the Detachment Commander stationed in Kodiak, but the day to day enforcement activities directed by the Corporal who was stationed in Sandpoint.

COOK INLET

The Cook Inlet fishery was handled by five of the seven permanent officers stationed on the Kenai Peninsula at Soldotna, Homer, and Seward. A twenty-five foot Bertram patrol boat which is normally trailered to launching sites on the inlet was used only once due to a major breakdown of the vessel. A four wheel drive vehicle is a major enforcement tool for the set net fisheries on the beaches of Cook Inlet and the only accessible way to contact these individuals. Contact is made with the use of an Avon inflatable boat. A State-owned Supercub aircraft and charter aircraft provided the necessary air coverage. Four temporary officers were hired to assist the permanent officers. These temporaries are used to contact the set netters along the beaches in the commercial fisheries and as contacts with the flood of sport fishermen who come to the Kenai to sport fish during the summer.

PRINCE WILLIAM SOUND (CORDOVA, VALDEZ AND WHITTIER)

One permanent officer in Cordova, two permanent officers in Valdez and two permanent Protection officers TDY from Soldotna at Whittier comprised the permanent staff assigned to Prince William Sound commercial fisheries. A total of six temporary employees were assigned to Prince William Sound -- three to Cordova, two to Valdez and one to Whittier. Their duties consisted of running small boats for patrol purposes and as stream guards and stake-out teams and as second officers aboard the thirty-eight foot patrol boat stationed out of Valdez. The smaller boats used in these operations were two twenty-one foot Boston Whaler outboard powered boats and two nineteen foot Bellboy outboard powered boats. These boats were assigned patrol areas throughout the season using either two temporary or one temporary and one permanent officer to each boat. As determined by projected needs to best protect the resource, these units often act as a stream guard operation. That

is, living in plain sight to prevent the taking of salmon bound for escape-ment in that stream. In some instances, stake-out concept is also used. A State-owned Dehaviland Beaver aircraft was stationed in Cordova flown by the Cordova officer throughout Prince William Sound both for patrol and transporting stream guard, stake-out and supplying vessel operations. Also, working in conjunction with the patrol boats both in Valdez and Whittier and other patrol units. The coordination of this program being supervised by a man in field. The assistance and cooperation of the Fish & Game area management fisheries biologist at Cordova was a major contributor to the enforcement activities within the Sound. The thirty-eight foot vessel Balaena out of Valdez operated in the fishery with one permanent Valdez officer and one temporary officer aboard and occasionally with the second permanent officer on board. A nineteen foot Bellboy was also used as a patrol vessel usually with the second permanent officer from Valdez operating it so as to cover more area. Both vessels were used for patrol and in stream guard operations and for supplying and transporting of stake-out crews and stream guards to vulnerable areas. In addition, two permanent officers on temporary duty assignment from Soldotna were sent to Whittier utilizing a nineteen foot Bellboy, they worked much of the northern areas of Prince William Sound in conjunction with the Valdez and Cordova officers' aircraft and vessels.

SOUTHEAST

Excluding Yakutat, Southeastern Alaska has six Fish & Wildlife stations. These being located at Juneau, Haines, Sitka, Petersburg, Wrangell and Ketchikan. Juneau has two permanent officers, Haines - one permanent officer, Sitka - one permanent officer, Petersburg - one permanent officer, Wrangell - one permanent officer and Ketchikan - two permanent officers. Ten temporary employees were hired for the Southeastern Detachment during the salmon seasons.

Four of these temporaries were assigned to a roving patrol unit. This being seventeen foot Boston Whaler outboard boats. One of these teams and boats assigned to northern Southeastern waters (Juneau to Petersburg) and the other to the southern portion of Southeastern Alaska (Ketchikan to Petersburg). Their prime duty is to patrol the fishing areas within an assigned area measuring gear, checking licenses and permits, and as stream guard and stake-out team members depending on the priorities. These team members ran these boats throughout the assigned areas as scheduled by the Detachment Commander and the post officer where they were operating out of at any particular time. They traveled and lived in these skiffs throughout the seasons camping on the beaches with the equipment they carry aboard. They may at any time be directed to travel to a given area and act as a stream guard team for a particularly vulnerable stream or to tie up their boat and to act as a stake-out team on a predetermined stream for a period of time. However, always returning to the roving patrol concept upon completion of their assignments. The remaining six temporary employees were assigned one to each of the post stations to assist the post officers in carrying out patrol activity including assisting in the operation of the two thirty-eight foot Bertrams, one stationed in Ketchikan and one in Juneau, and operating smaller outboard boats for patrol work. Due to the small number of temporaries available, it was often necessary to use single-man teams both for stream guards and stake-out programs. In other instances, temporaries from one post would be joined with a temporary from another post to make a team both for their safety and for the corroboration of any evidence obtained. As in other areas of the State, the manpower and equipment available, such as vessels, aircraft and personnel, are dispersed into the fishing areas usually after consultation with the area management biologist as to salmon runs in particular areas, expected activities and other known problem areas. Beginning with the Haines post, the enforcement program called for the post officer to operate a twenty-five foot Bertram patrol craft in the fisheries of Upper Lynn Canal. At times he would be accompanied by the temporary employee or in other cases, having the temporary fulfilling duties in other areas of the district. Charter aircraft was used throughout the season. In Juneau one permanent officer operating a thirty-eight foot Bertram, and a temporary employee to assist, patrolled the waters north of Seymour Canal, Icy Straits, portions of Lynn Canal and Chatham Straits south to Kelp Bay. Wherever fisheries existed in this area the thirty-eight foot Bertram was the vessel used in these fisheries. The second permanent officer, the Detachment Commander, also assisted in making patrols both by aircraft and vessel. The Petersburg officer, utilizing the twenty-five foot Bertram patrol craft, patrolled all the waters north of Wrangell Narrows including Frederick Sound, Stephans Passage to Seymour Canal, and the mainland (the eastern shore) of Admiralty Island to Tyee. A floating Wannigan, located at Pybus Bay, was used as a fuel depot and living quarters for the vessel crew so that it was able to operate in the center of the fisheries. The temporary employee assisted the officer in the operation of the vessel and acted as a stream guard and stake-out team. Air charter services were used for air surveillance. The Sitka officer, using a twenty-two foot outboard powered boat, was responsible for Peril Straits, Lower Chatham Straits, the outer waters of Baranof and Chichagof Islands. The use of temporary manpower was to assist the officer in the operation of the vessel and as stream

guard and stake-out teams. Air charter services were used for air surveillance programs. The Wrangell officer, using a twenty-three foot inboard vessel, delt primarily with the gill net fisheries in Districts six, seven and eight of Sumner Straits and Clarence Straits but was also responsible for the patrol of El Capitan Straits north of Craig. Temporary employees were used both to assist the officer in the operation of the vessel patrols and as stream guard and stake-out teams. Air charter services were used for air surveillance. The Ketchikan officers, one of which was assigned to the thirty-eight foot Bertram patrol vessel, responsible for all waters south of Meyers Chuck to the Canadian border, east to Hyder and Port Steward, British Columbia, and west to three miles offshore of Dall and Prince of Wales Islands including the inside waters to Craig. A floating Wannigan, located in Elbow Bay on Long Island, was used as a fuel depot and living quarters for a stream guard concept program both for the large vessel and for a smaller vessel patrolling the waters of Cordova Bay. Temporary employees were used to assist the officers and as stream guard and stake-out. In both Juneau and Ketchikan, the members of the roving team were at one time or another called in to act as a stream guard or a stake-out team when need required. Charter aircraft was used for air surveillance of these fisheries.

SUBJECT: C.F. Enforcement-Region I

Copies of ~~your memo~~ have been routed to all offices for comments. In the mean time I would like to repeat what we discussed earlier. As far as Southeastern region is concerned, my staff still feels that the stake-out system has been the most effective method of enforcement for the salmon purse seine fleet. I was invited to talk to the S.E. detachment recently. I voiced my opinion of stake-outs and received the expected response. They plan to continue the program, but it is not a super popular scheme with the officers. It is a pain dealing with temporaries--no one knows this better than I. New, more sophisticated methods appeal to the troopers I realize. Redstone's photo idea sounds good to some I'm sure. It would be easier for one thing. My suggestion, however, is to run an aggressive stake-out program with as much funding as possible. The new approaches can be run on a limited experimental basis if desired, but I don't feel that stake-outs should be phased out unless a proven substitute is available. Aircraft patrols and fast speed boats do not catch creek robbers. We both know this.

The gillnet team idea seems to work and should be continued. When the gillnet mesh restriction program goes into effect, extra effort will be needed. Our staff is instructed to assist your men in this regard with support facilities and personnel as available. We realize that this new regulation will create enforcement problems for which you are not budgeted.

Dear Mr. Gross:

There is an extreme amount of concern among my constituents regarding the prosecution and conviction of fish and game violations.

It was recently suggested during my trip to Ketchikan on February 4 and 5 that one possible solution may be to establish some expertise in fish and game violations within the District Attorney's or Attorney General's offices. The possibility was suggested of forming a small group of district attorneys whom would specialize in prosecuting fish and game violations throughout the state. I would appreciate your comment on the feasibility of the concept.

Also, I would like to have a brief report of the following:

- 1.0 Number of fish and game violations and complaints filed in 1976
- 2.0 Number which resulted in prosecution
- 3.0 Number of convictions along with the sentences received for the violations
- 4.0 A brief analysis regarding the reasons for the unsuccessful conviction and whether or not the case was judge or jury tried
- 5.0 A break down of the violations, prosecutions and convictions by area within the state. A judicial district break down would be sufficient.

I would appreciate your candid comments of whether the numbers of fishery violations which are not successfully prosecuted through conviction are a result of a lack of experience on the investigation level by the officers involved, or a lack of expertise on the part of the district attorneys prosecuting the cases.


Per your request the attached list is the total number of fish that were seized during 1976 by officers within this detachment (all of S.E.).

As you will notice only two (2) fish were seized from defendants who were fishing in closed waters.

The one case where 679 pounds of salmon was seized, the salmon was sold to the cannery and the check from same was deposited in the state's general fund. All other cases where individual fish or small quantities of fish were seized the fish are distributed to non-profit organizations such as the State Correctional Institution, Childrens Home, Receiving home, and to people on welfare and/or those people to old to fish and in need, such as the older people of Klukwan.

SUBJECT: Fish & Wildlife Violation
Statistics

The attached report contains violations for which individuals were cited in 1976 and for which final court dispositions have been received. Dispositions have not been received for all 1976 citations, therefore, this report does not reflect complete statistics, but only approximately 90 to 95 percent of the total.

The attached report is broken down by Detachment and type of violation. The middle columns headed "Fine" and "Jail" reflect the sentence received for those found guilty. The right hand column headed "verd" is the final verdict. In the verdict column number 1 reflects guilty; number 2 reflects not guilty; and a blank reflects the individual did not go to court, (which could be because defendant was a juvenile; deferred prosecution; DA declined prosecution; etc.).

In regard to item 2 in Representative Gardiner's letter - this is not available on the computer run. I'm not sure exactly what figure he is reaching for. By pulling each individual case report from file we could manually tally how many cases had a prosecuting attorney, (which several cases do not due to the location where the defendant appears in court and the officer must present the case). I'm not sure a hand tally would reflect how many cases the DA declined prosecution. I estimate the hand tally would take at least one month, unless the clerk's entire effort was switched to this one project.

Following is a list of violations broken down by each category and Detachment. These include 100 violation reports with dispositions which have been received in R & I, but not keypunched, therefore, not included in the attached computer printout.

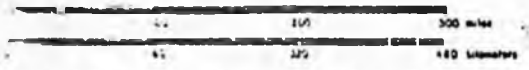
