

All of this money could maintain the haul road they say will cost so much to let people use. It could build a lot of other roads we need in Alaska and make some we already have a lot better and a lot safer. It could build some of the schools, jails, court houses and docks they keep putting on bond issues asking the voters to approve.

I ask all of you to do what you can to defeat HB 192. And I think you ought to do everything possible to help pass the bill, SB 199, to repeal the first law that allowed the Governor to buy back these leases in the first place. Let the courts decide what is right on them. That's where it started and that's where the decision should be made, not laws from the Governor and the Legislature.

Again I don't want my tax dollars spent to pay off the oil companies. Let them find out what they bought. Some people think there is more natural gas than oil in Kachemak Bay anyway. They need gas on the Kenai Peninsula. Let the people have a chance to work and let them have the energy they need for a little progress.
