

Recently, several misstatements related to the positions and purposes of the Alliance for Juneau's Future, Inc. and its relationship to the previous executive director have been published. The Executive Committee of the Alliance for Juneau's Future, Inc. wishes to correct the public record because these misstatements have been made in conjunction with the confirmation hearings for the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Conservation, John A. Sandor.

The Alliance was founded in April of 1989 by a group of concerned Juneau citizens to promote environmentally responsible economic development. After several months as an all-volunteer organization, John Sandor was selected as the organization's first executive director because of his broad experience and expertise in resource management. John Sandor is widely respected for his integrity and professionalism within the public and the private sector. As the executive director of the Alliance, John Sandor's credibility and commitment to environmentally sound development assisted the organization's growth during its early years and encouraged constructive dialogue regarding Juneau's economic development.

The Alliance has grown to a broad based, multi-purposed group of over 600 members devoted to diversification of Juneau's economy. Our concerns are varied and diverse within the context of environmentally responsible economic development. We have strongly supported important aspects of our community's development such as DIPAC, revision of the Tongass NF Land Management Plan, enhanced airline service to Juneau by Canadian airlines, new road access to Juneau and improvement of the Alaskan Marine Highway System. We have attached a full list of our purposes and objectives as approved by our Board of Directors.


The Alliance did not take a position on the A-J Mine until late March of this year - nearly four months after John Sandor left the organization. The Alliance decided only after a careful review of the A-J Mine Draft Environmental Impact Statement that the mine proposal should be allowed to go forward. The reviewing committees, composed of over 70 Alliance members, formulated a number of recommendations and

suggestions designed to strengthen the Final EIS and sent them to the Bureau of Land Management. The Alliance is circumspect in selecting projects to support. We require a high level of civic responsibility and strong community enhancement from the project.



I would like to urge you to vote against confirmation of Commissioners: John Sandor and Harold Heintz. I firmly believe that both men represent "the fox guarding the hen house" syndrome, and are therefore not in the best interest of the State and its citizens who depend on and trust the Commissioner level of State staff members to serve their best interests.

I sat through hours of hearings in both the House and Senate Resources Committees concerning John Sandor. I felt that he was evasive in his answers to the Legislators, who were asking fair and reasonable questions. How can the system of checks and balances in our Government work if the Commissioner is so arrogant and deceitful that he feels that he does not have to answer to our Legislators? - institute heavy fines for individuals and corporations for willfully negligent disposal of garbage and toxins—land, sea and air;

- immediate introduction of recycling of all of our waste stream; paper, plastic, glass, aluminum, tin, metal, compostables, and encourage industries in the state who will reconstitute and recycle these byproducts of civilization back into new products. RECYCLING AND URBAN MINING WILL BE TWO OF THE MAJOR PROFIT INDUSTRIES OF THE 21ST CENTURY; they who begin now will BE blue chip by the early to mid 21st century!
- tourism will also be one of the world's leading for profit industries of the 21st century. Let's preserve what we've got, because others are screaming for it! As more third world countries become financially solvent, their people will travel as first world people with expendable income do now = a top 10 industry of the 21st century (maybe even top five!)
- actively promote global village approach—a state known for innovative ideas in conflict resolution and dissolving boundaries, resolving ideological differences for a safer, healthier world. Already we are a shining example and have shown our commitment in this area, e.g., Alaskan Siberian project; Dixie Belcher's groups; ice classic; government and business exchanges between Alaska and Siberia. During controversial confirmation hearings it seems that someone always chimes in that a President (or Governor) should be allowed to pick his cabinet without undue interference from the legislative body, allowing him to pursue his agenda. In the case of Mr. Hickel's appointment of John Sandor, I urge the legislature to reject any such notion. The power of the legislature to confirm or not confirm is central to the concept of checks and balances, and provides stability to democratic governments by preventing a mis-guided chief executive from running amuck.

The appointment of John Sandor is clear indication that Wally Hickel is running amuck. DEC is charged with the responsibility of protecting public health and welfare and the integrity of the environment. This is a vital responsibility, and to be successful the agency must execute the law fully and must function above politics. The agency must act on professional judgement, not on political motivation. It is the legislature's responsibility to assure that whoever is appointed as Commissioner has a heartfelt dedication to lead the agency in fulfilling statutory policy both in spirit and letter. John Sandor is not that man. This is the time to invoke the "check" of checks and balances.

Having watched Mr. Sandor for many years while he was Regional Forester for Alaska, I have no doubt and every assurance that his administration of DEC will be an absolute failure. The price of this failure will be paid by the citizens of Alaska not only during his tenure, but very likely for many decades (if no generations) to come -- such is the nature of hazardous wastes, oil spills, and toxic discharges to air and water.

I offer this relevant anecdote about Mr. Sandor. After many years of preparation, the Forest Service issued the Tongass Land Management Plan (TLMP) in 1979. Among other things it established four land classifications (known as Land Use Designations, or 'LUDs'). Every watershed is classified as one of these LUDs, which range from LUD I (~~identifying congressionally designated wilderness~~ ^{DESIGNATED WILDERNESS AREAS}) to LUD IV (open to intensive logging). The draft TLMP classifications were made by an Interdisciplinary Team (IDT) composed of Forest Service professionals with expertise in a variety of areas, such as forestry, soils, hydrology, and wildlife habitat. The IDT decision was that the Kadashan

River drainage be classified LUD II, which is closed to logging. Mr. Sandor rescinded the IDT's decision, and by executive fiat he designated Kadashan LUD III — open to logging.

There was nothing in law or regulation which dictated or even suggested that a LUD III designation was called for; the LUD III designation was simply made on Mr. Sandor's personal whim. Mr. Sandor then commenced construction of a major arterial logging road through the drainage, and that action resulted in immediate, successful litigation by the Southeast Alaska Conservation Council. Mr. Sandor continued construction until SEACC obtained an injunction. On all counts -- Mr. Sandor's single-minded LUD-III designation, his letting of the construction contract under threat of suit, and his continuance of construction after litigation was begun -- on all of these counts, Mr. Sandor's action cost the federal government many millions of dollars, and if not stopped would have resulted in severe damage to resources. Last year Congress made the original IDT proposal law by making Kadashan a Congressionally designated LUD-II area.

Mr. Sandor's decisions on Kadashan were wrong at every step, and were contrary to the recommendations of his staff professionals. Not only were his decisions on Kadashan disparaged by his professionals, but also by the other two branches of government — Congress and the courts. — Why? — The reason is that Sitka's Alaska Pulp Corporation was fighting tooth and nail to get into Kadashan and log it. Kadashan was the number-one place that APC wanted to get into. Simply put, Mr. Sandor went to bat for a logging company rather than follow a proper course of action charted by his professionals.

Kadashan illustrates but one of Mr. Sandor's fiduciary failures. Other policies and decisions instituted by Mr. Sandor while he was Regional Forester are at the core of other successful litigation throughout the Tongass National Forest. Mr. Sandor retired before this litigation was brought, but he is responsible for much of it. DEC has the important roll of TRUSTEE — that is the word in the statutes — of TRUSTEE of the health and welfare of Alaska's people and environment. Although Mr. Sandor may be well suited for leadership in the private advocacy organization which is promoting mining in Juneau, he is no Trustee. He is absolutely unsuitable to be Commissioner of DEC.

Mr. Chairman and members of the Committee:

My name is Florian Sever, and I am here today testifying on behalf of The Foundation for the Protection of the Common People, Inc. Our organization is one which is dedicated to the protection of the civil and human rights of all individuals; and to promoting the compliance with all environmental laws and regulations.

I oppose the confirmation of John Sandor as Commissioner of ADEC; and urge you to reject his appointment. Mr. Sandor's philosophy in regard to the environment, is aligned with the major polluters in Alaska. Mr. Sandor possesses neither, the credentials; nor the will, needed to protect the right every Alaskan has to enjoy a clean, healthy environment. His past record with the USFS demonstrates his willingness to sacrifice the environment, in order to appease industry.

Mr. Sandor's appointment to this post was an exercise in blatant "cronyism"; his appointment is a simple extension of this administration's standing policy to hand out "juicy" commissions to those who are loyal to the "Hickel Dream".

The past timber management policy on the Tongass National Forest, in Southeast Alaska, was largely the brain-child of Mr. Sandor, and men like him. The legacy of this ill-conceived "give away" of public resources has yet to fully experienced . . . the damage to the environment, caused by this policy, is both extensive, and long lasting.

I had the opportunity and honor to testify on behalf of the Tongass Timber Reform Act, on several occasions, before various committees of the U.S. Congress. I was fired from two consecutive jobs for doing so.

The allegations of mismanagement and impropriety, which led to the introduction of the Tongass Timber Reform Act, by U.S. Representative Bob Mrazek, (D) New York, have been recognized and affirmed by both, the Congress of the United States, and President Bush; this was manifested in the signing of the Act into law, in November, 1990. The signing of the TTRA was a repudiation of Mr. Sandor's policies and philosophy.

Mr. Sandor was a principal architect of the policies which the Act tried to remedy. These USFS policies condoned, among others, . . . "price fixing" . . . timber monopolies . . . "high grading" of the "old growth" forest . . . logging right across fish streams . . . collusive bidding practices by the 50-year timber contract holders (Alaska Pulp and Ketchikan Pulp) . . . illegal "double-invoicing" of cedar logs . . . illegal collusion to force independent timber operators out of business . . . and "blacklisting" of critics of these policies.

Mr. Sandor's appointment to the post of Commissioner of ADEC is an affront, and an embarrassment, to the general public. His confirmation would be a travesty, and a "slap in the face" to all Alaskans who have any concern for the conservation of our fragile environment.


During his career with the USFS, Mr. Sandor played the role of both "handmaiden", and protector, to two of the largest polluters of the environment in the state of Alaska; Alaska Pulp Corporation, and Ketchikan Pulp Company. 





I had the opportunity and honor to testify on behalf of the Tongass Timber Reform Act, on several occasions, before various committees of the U.S. Congress. I was fired from two consecutive jobs for doing so.

The allegations of mismanagement and impropriety, which led to the introduction of the Tongass Timber Reform Act, by U.S. Representative Bob Mrazek, (D) New York, have been recognized and affirmed by both, the Congress of the United States, and President Bush; this was manifested in the signing of the Act into law, in November, 1990. The signing of the TTRA was a repudiation of Mr. Sandor's policies and philosophy.

Mr. Sandor was a principal architect of the policies which the Act tried to remedy. These USFS policies condoned, among others, . . . "price fixing" . . . timber monopolies . . . "high grading" of the "old growth" forest . . . logging right across fish streams . . . collusive bidding practices by the 50-year timber contract holders (Alaska Pulp and Ketchikan Pulp) . . . illegal "double-invoicing" of cedar logs . . . illegal collusion to force independent timber operators out of business . . . and "blacklisting" of critics of these policies.

Mr. Sandor's appointment to the post of Commissioner of ADEC is an affront, and an embarrassment, to the general public. His confirmation would be a travesty, and a "slap in the face" to all Alaskans who have any concern for the conservation of our fragile environment.

During his career with the USFS, Mr. Sandor played the role of both "handmaiden", and protector, to two of the largest polluters of the environment in the state of Alaska; Alaska Pulp Corporation, and Ketchikan Pulp Company. APC, and KPC, have both proven, over the last 30 years, to be aggressive polluters of both the air, and the water. Neither company has ~~ever~~ been in compliance with either the federal Clean Air Act, or the federal Clean Water Act. Will Mr. Sandor force them into compliance? I hardly think so.


