DESCRIPTION: 9-13 members: 3 are members who have been appointed by Governor to the Personnel Board, Dept. of Administration; 2 shall be members of the system and elected by the members of the system for 6-year terms; and 2 physicians each from at least 2 of the State's 4 judicial districts (minimum of 4 physician members and maximum of 8).

SPECIAL FACTS: Physician members serve at the pleasure of the Governor. Board expense paid from Public Employees' Retirement fund. P.E.R.B. and the Alaska Teachers' Retirement Board (T.R.B.) may submit to the Governor a list of recommended physicians. Physician members only serve for the purpose of hearing appeals to determine medical eligibility for disability benefits. The 2 physician members from the judicial district (j.d.) in which a disability appeal hearing is conducted shall serve on the board during the hearing. If 1 or more of the physicians in the judicial district in which a disability hearing is conducted is unable to serve at the hearing, or if there is no physician member from the judicial district, other physician members shall serve at the hearing, selected for such hearings on a rotating basis, in accordance with regulations adopted by the board. Governor may appoint physician members to serve on both P.E.R.B. & T.R.B.

FUNCTION: Prescribes policies, regulations and other activities to administer the Public Employees' Retirement System, The Supplemental Benefits System (S.B.S.), and the Deferred Compensation Program (D.C.P.); serves as an appeals board.

COMPENSATION: Standard travel/per diem. Physicians are entitled to hourly compensation at a rate to be determined by the Commissioner of Administration, which shall be consistent with the physicians' normal hourly earnings.

MEETINGS: 2 times a year; special hearings as necessary.

Assesses penalties for substantial noncompliance with reporting requirements, recommends removal from the ballot or office in accordance with law, and adjudicates complaints through approval of settlements and through public hearings under the Administrative Procedure Act.
