

TOWN MEETING ON ALL WEST AREA SCHOOLS
Senate Hearing on Romig and West High Renovations

A bill has been introduced in the legislature (Senate Bill 18 by Senators Ellis, Leman & Donley) to fund improvements to bring West High and Romig up to the school district's standard for secondary schools in Anchorage. Senator Leman has scheduled a work session for the Senate State Affairs Committee on this bill for Saturday, February 13 at 1:30 at the West-Romig Library.

The School Board, Assembly and Mayor are considering an April bond issue which will affect all West area students.

This funding is critical because West is in the worst physical condition of any high school in the district, and Romig's facility is the worst junior high.

These are some of the conditions our children will soon face:

1. West Science Rooms have electrical hazards, leaky plumbing, faulty gas jets, inadequate exits and no sprinklers. Romig's lack basic safety equipment, clean water, electrical outlets, sinks and gas.
2. West and Romig share a library which impacts Romig's students' ability to use the library.
3. At West, the 40-year-old electrical system is inadequate to demand, and suffers from breakdowns in wiring insulation, overloaded circuits, asbestos, worn out receptacles, and lack of ground fault interrupters.
4. The West cafeteria seats only 1/3 of the students, so they are obliged to eat their lunch on the floor, in the halls, or out of the building.
5. Repair and replacements of furnishings, books and equipment over the 40-year history of West, 30-years at Romig, have failed to keep pace with educational needs.
6. At both schools, inadequate and inequitable athletic facilities include one-half the gymnasium capacity of other secondary schools and dangerous and inadequate swimming pool, track, hockey rink, soccer and football fields, tennis courts, wrestling room, rifle range, and gymnastics area.
7. West and Romig have 5,100 students in elementary feeder schools.
