Section 8

The change made by section 8 is located on page 5, line 5. This would allow AHFC to make loans for rural non-owner occupied housing, to the extent feasible, to someone who already has an AHFC loan for an existing owner-occupied residence.

The language in section 8 would not change any current practice since AHFC already interprets this statute to allow a qualified borrower to have more than one non-owner occupied loan. Section 8 would clarify the statute to more clearly make this type of loan allowable.

Section 9

This expands the existing Building Materials Loan Program to allow for small (\$20,000 or less) unsecured loans for borrowers who have either restrictive deed lands or have no title to their HUD Mutual Help home. These borrowers have financing needs for repairs and/or improvements to their homes, but are unable to pledge their home as collateral or have native restricted deed land that is cost prohibitive in obtaining required BLA approval for encumbering the property.

Section 10

This is a conforming change to coordinate this statute with the change being made in the first part of section 12.

Section 11

This is a conforming change to coordinate this statute with the change being made in the first part of section 12.

Section 12

Beginning on page 6, lines 14 and 15, the definition of non-owner occupied housing would be clarified as rental housing. On line 16, the definition of a multi-family rental house is changed from an eight to a 16 dwelling unit. Please note that the existing statute (shown on lines 17 - 19) allows AHFC to modify this definition if AHFC determines there is special needs and qualified tenants that shows going beyond an eight unit project is warranted. Borrowers can save costs on projects with up to 16 units by avoiding having to do a special determinations as required by the current statute.

Section 13

The current definition in statute limits the term "housing" to either single-family and owner-occupied duplexes. Section 13 would bring this term into compliance with industry standards that view the term "housing" as owner-occupied housing with up to four units. This is the standard that is used by the VA, FHA, Fannie Mae, Freddie Mac, and AHFC conventional urban loans.



This section would also increase the population base for communities eligible to participate in the rural loan program from 5,500 to 6,500 for communities not connected to Anchorage or Fairbanks by road or rail OR from 1,400 to 1,600 for communities on the road system. Currently the population of Bethel is approaching 5,200 with a continuing pattern of growth. Haines' population exceeded 1,400 a year ago, and then dropped down to less than 1,400 this year. By increasing the population to 1,600, communities like Haines have an opportunity for growth and are still eligible to participate in our rural loan program. Alternative financing is generally not available from national secondary market sources.

Representative Foster -- thank you for your sponsorship of this legislation. I look forward to working with you and your staff toward the passage of this bill. Staff from the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation's mortgage office will be on hand to brief legislators at the House Finance Committee hearing scheduled for Wednesday, March 13. If anyone has any questions in the meantime, please do not hesitate to give me a call.

Dear Chairman Sharp,

My name is Bruce Kovarik, and I am the Executive Director of the Bering Straits Regional Housing Authority which serves 16 communities from our regional center here in Nome. I am offering testimony in support of HB 192 on behalf of our Housing Authority as well as the Association of Alaska Housing Authorities which represents Alaska's 14 Regional Housing Authorities and the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation.

First, I would like to thank Representative Richard Foster for his support and sponsorship of this Legislation and you, Mr. Chairman, for scheduling this hearing today before the Senate State Affairs Committee.

HB 192 has significant importance for Alaska's Regional Housing Authorities in our mission to provide decent, safe, sanitary, and affordable housing to families throughout Alaska and in the development of our rural communities.

Section 1 expands the ability of the RHAs to originate and service AHFC loans for the purchase and development of residential housing. Despite progress in developing new housing in our rural and urban communities, it's clear that we need to utilize every possible resource to meet Alaska's varied housing needs. Existing and future loan programs from AHFC will play an important role, and this provision of HB 192 will be a valuable tool in meeting that need.

Several of the housing programs now available from AHFC and others (e.g., Farmers Home Administration and the Veterans Administration) are severely under-utilized in rural Alaska. Part of the reason is certainly village economics, but another part is the

lack of rural access to information and the basic mechanics of loan programs. There are low and moderate income families in our region and throughout the State which can benefit from one or more of these programs and achieve their goals of homeownership. In most cases, a successful home loan will require much more effort than with more affluent families or in communities with better access to lending institutions. The Regional Housing Authorities are a logical choice for making the extra effort.


There is also virtually no tradition for conventional mortgage lending and housing development in rural Alaska. But there appears to be no alternative except to develop this tradition in some form to meet the enormous need for housing in Alaska. Expanding access to AHFC loans as this bill does, coordination with lending institutions, and the recent willingness of the secondary mortgage market (FHA, FNMA, FHLMC etc.) to participate in rural housing programs appear as the few bright spots on the horizon. The Regional Housing Authorities and AHFC have begun to demonstrate the effectiveness of these programs and we need to continue to take these first, small steps toward a tradition of mortgage lending.

Section 2 expands the eligible activities of the Supplemental Housing Grant Program to include off-site sewer & water work which further recognizes the significant community infrastructure development which is a part of all of our housing projects. While the amount of effort necessary for infrastructure development (roads, power, water & sewer) varies from project to project, it is clear that the ability to use SHG funds will improve our ability to better coordinate with other federal, state and local resources. There is no change in the financial contribution of the program.

Sections 6-13 make meaningful improvements in AHFC programs which offer more practical relevance to rural loan programs and offer greater flexibility for housing development.

Thank you again for this opportunity to offer testimony today. On behalf of the Association of Alaska Housing Authorities and the Bering Straits Regional Housing Authority, I ask for your support for this legislation and urge you to pass HB192 from your committee today.

Fiscal Note Analysis
House Bill 198

This bill amends the Definitions section of AS 43.23.095(8) by adding two additional allowable absences to the list of absences allowable for purposes of qualifying for a Permanent Fund Dividend. The proposed additional absences are: caring for the individual's terminally ill parent, spouse, sibling, child, or step-child; and absence from the state to settle the estate of the individual's deceased parent, spouse, sibling, child, or step-child. The effective date of this bill is January 1, 1996.

The fiscal effects of this bill are minimal and can be absorbed by the PFD Division.

**CSHB 198 (STA)
PFD Bereavement Absence**

Sponsor Statement

CSHB 198 adds three allowable absences to residency determinations under the permanent fund dividend program:

- (1) for the purpose of caring for a family member with a critical, life-threatening illness;
- (2) for the purpose of caring for a terminally ill family member;
- (3) for the purpose of settling the estate of a deceased family member.

Family member is defined in the bill as "parent, spouse, sibling, child, or step-child."

Care of a critically or terminally ill family member is an important family responsibility with both family and societal benefits. Family care provides the opportunity to express the love and support necessary to ease the pain of a person's most difficult days and weeks of life. Care provided by family members lowers the cost of health care for individuals who would otherwise be institutionalized, and thus lowers health care costs for society. Settling the estate of a family member is one of the unavoidable and burdensome duties imposed by death. Alaskans who undertake these difficult family responsibilities should not be punished financially by losing their permanent fund dividends.

The bill has a zero fiscal note. It is unknown at this time how many Alaskans might apply for a "bereavement absence" because the agency has not recorded this data from past applications. If the number of persons absent for this reason is small, it will have a negligible effect on the amount of the permanent fund dividend. CSHB 198 has no effect on the general fund; there are no additional processing costs anticipated by the Permanent Fund Dividend Division.

CSHB 198 is supported by the American Association of Retired Persons, the Alaska Geriatric Exchange Network (AGENET), and the Alaska Women's Lobby.

The Alaska Geriatric Network Exchange (AGENET) is pleased to be asked to support HB 198 which would allow Alaskans absence from the state to care for a terminally ill family member or settle the estate of a deceased family member.

Members of AGENET are well aware of the need for Alaskans to care for family members. We, in managing senior services across the state, understand the situations described above. We advocate for Alaskans who have family members outside of Alaska to be able to care for those individuals so that honor and dignity remain with the terminally ill person as well as the caregivers as long as possible.

AGENET members also clearly understand the need to grieve a loved one and the importance of being able to do so in a proper manner. By allowing a "bereavement absence" for Alaskans, individuals would be able to be with other family members during a relative's death and be able to be a supportive family members in staying to take care of estate settlements.

Due to the geography and distance for those of us who choose to live in this beautiful state, it is difficult to even travel to get to family members who are terminally ill. HB 198 would allow Alaskans to be able take the time and care each of us would want to give to our loved ones who are sick and dying without suffering further financial penalties.

Thank you, Representative Elton, for introducing HB 198. It is a bill that will enhance Alaskans' role in caring for their families though they may be thousands of miles away.

POSITION PAPER ON PFD BEREAVEMENT ABSENCES - HB 198

The Alaska Women's Lobby strongly supports the creation of an additional allowable absence for PFD eligibility.

HB 198 would allow a resident an excused absence for the purpose of caring for a terminally ill family member and for the settling of the family member's estate after death.

Many Alaskans have elderly family members living in other states. It is also fairly common for seriously ill Alaskans to travel out of state for specialized medical care. It is very important for the family unit that a person be able to care for a parent or a spouse who has a serious health condition.

Three quarters of all caregivers for older people are women. The caregiver's burden is a heavy one. He or she should not have to also suffer the additional penalty of being denied PFD eligibility.

We believe it is simply good public policy to lend support to families by encouraging rather than discouraging residents to provide personal care for terminally ill family members.

We urge the passage of HB 198.

Sponsor Statement
CSHB 211 (FIN)

The goal of CSHB 211 is to decrease the need for questioned ballots in the primary and general elections by assuring the accuracy of the official voters registration list. This legislation accomplishes the goal in three ways. First, CSHB 211 changes the composition of the official registration list. Second, it provides for more frequent purging of convicted felons and deceased voters. Third, this bill increases communication from the Division of Elections, to absentee voters, and to questioned ballot voters.

The first and second sections of HB 211 call for the addition of inactive "active" voters to the list kept at each polling place. An inactive "active" voter is a person who has not voted for the past two years, is registered, and whose name does not appear on the official registration list. When a voter with this status arrives at the poll to vote, a questioned ballot must be cast. If a list of the inactive "active" voters is available at the polling place a voters name and ID can be checked. This will eliminate the need for a questioned ballot. Recently, the Division of Elections estimated the addition of this list would decrease questioned ballot need by approximately 1500-2000 votes statewide.

The thrid and fourth sections of this bill direct the Division of Elections to purge deceased voters monthly, and convicted felons promptly. There is a gap of time between conviction and sentencing of a felon. If the division of elections does not obtain the necessary information from the Dept. of Corrections regarding felony convictions the names are not purged from the official voter list. Potentially, a convicted felon could vote before his/her name is purged.

Sections fifth through nine of CSHB 211 will increase communications from the Division of Elections, to absentee voters and to questioned ballot voters, after the primary. This bill directs the Division of Elections to notify a voter of the status of a vote challenge no later than 10 days after the certification of the primary when a questioned or absentee ballot is totally rejected or partially rejected in the primary.

During the 1994 primary there were 6,990 questioned ballots statewide. That number does not include totally rejected ballots, because ballots that are totally rejected are not counted as a vote on the official registration list. Of the 6,990 primary questioned ballot voters 1,640 also voted a questioned ballot in the general election. If the voters knew the status of their votes soon after the primary, many might have taken corrective action before the general election. The result: less questioned ballots in the general. However, that was not the case. There were 14,144 questioned ballots statewide during the 1994 general election, of these 5,131 questioned ballots were totally counted, 7,883 questioned ballots were partially rejected, and 1,129 questioned ballots were totally rejected. Many people who voted questioned ballots in the primary had to do so again in the general because not all the problems were rectified between the primary and general elections. These people were not made aware that their votes for district representative and senator did not count until well after the general election was certified.

The final section of CSHB 211, section ten, prohibits the appointment of any state employees to the data processing review board. This provision will keep the data processing review board objective and impartial. Our States last data review board was largely made up of state employees.

CSHB 211 provides a means of decreasing the number of questioned ballots cast in our state. The many voters who were not aware of the status of their vote were disenfranchised. That does not have to happen. We all know one vote can change the outcome of an election. Give all the voters in our state the opportunity to have their vote counted, and give our Division of Elections the opportunity to help that process change more effectively. I urge your positive consideration of this legislation.

The Division of Elections opposes two sections of HB 211 scheduled for hearing in the Senate State Affairs committee on April 11, 1996.

Section 1, as amended would require all inactive voters to be included in the precinct lists for each election. Representative Bunde has said he intends this amendment to make it unnecessary for inactive voters to vote a questioned ballot at the polls. Although other portions of the elections statute would still require inactive voters to vote a questioned ballot, we think the proposed amendment would be cumbersome and confusing at the polls. Fairbanks Election Supervisor Shelly Growden notes that in military precincts, the amendment may mean an increase of 2000 voters to some rolls.

Although HB 211 would allow the precinct list to be divided into sections, inexperienced poll workers may allow inactive voters, whose names appear on any list available at the precinct, to vote regular ballots in error. Inactive voters who may want the poll workers to update incorrect information on the expanded precinct rolls would cause unnecessary delay for other voters waiting to vote. Voters who presently accept the requirement to vote a questioned ballot if their names are not on the precinct list, may refuse to do so if their names appear on any visible list at the polling place.


Requiring an inactive voter to vote a questioned ballot is an important way for the Division of Elections to obtain updated residence and mailing information necessary to assure a voter is listed in the correct precinct and to allow election information to be mailed to a voter's correct address. We presently plan to add inactive voters to our voter tapes. This will allow Representative Bunde and other candidates to purchase voter tapes containing either active or inactive voters, or both. However we oppose adding inactive voters to the precinct lists.

Section 9 would require the Division of Elections to send a written summary of the reason for the challenge of all partially counted ballots. This would mean mailing approximately 8000 additional letters. We would like to suggest to the committee that receiving such a letter will be discouraging to a voter, will not provide for any remedy in that election, and might further discourage a person from voting at all.

The Division believes an increased effort can be made to educate voters on the importance of updating registration records and of voting in one's assigned precinct by including such information in the Official Election Pamphlet, PSA and newspaper notices, etc. prior to an election rather than after the voter has voted.

Thank you for your further consideration of these concerns. Election Outreach Coordinator Diane Shriner will attend the April 11 Senate State Affairs committee hearing to answer questions or receive comments regarding our position on HB 211. She may also be reached at 465-3051.

Congratulations on your election win. I am aware that you have been investigating Division of Election problems. Since we perform work for almost all of the campaigns, we received an ear-full during the '94 elections.

Some of the candidates and party organizations have urged me to document these problems.

For 20 years we have worked closely with Elections personnel. From 1986 thru 1990, I was chairman of the Anchorage Elections Data Processing Review Board. Even though there has always been a high turnover in Elections staff, I have always found them to be hard working and conscientious. Much of the following is critical of Elections actions. I am not putting the blame on any staff members. Many of them became swamped with work, and worked far beyond the requirements of a normal job. Place any blame squarely on director Joe Swanson.

Attached are several problems we had or are still having. I have grouped them by:

1. Purged voters who voted without reregistering.
2. Voters assigned to the wrong district/precinct.
3. Unprocessed address changes.
4. Invalid residence addresses.
5. Data errors.
6. Data Processing Review Board Problems.

Thank you for your time. Let me know if I can be of assistance.

ATTACHMENT A

1. PURGED VOTERS WHO VOTED WITHOUT REREGISTERING.

Once a month the Division of Elections makes a new public version of the voters registration file available. Anyone can obtain a copy for \$165. We purchase each monthly tape. Included (since 1986) is an assension number (record number) which we use to match voters from one file to another.

By matching the state 10/17/94 public voters registration file to the 01/05/95 file on assension number, we can derive the following: The 10/17/94 file contained 339,871 registered voters which we were told included everyone that registered prior to the 10/09/94 deadline. Of those on the 10/17/94 file, 920 were not on the 1/5/95 file and 4496 voters were added. Of those that were added, 1543 had registration dates prior to 10/09/94 and also were flagged as having voted in the '94 general and with further research we found that their votes were counted. The explanation from Elections is that this occurred because of a change in the procedure for handling purged voters.

Elections is required to purge voters from the registration file if they have not voted in 2 years. The old procedure was that they had to reregister subject to a 30 day waiting period before they could vote. In this election any purged voter that showed up and voted was automatically reactivated and their vote was counted. In other words, purged voters were really still registered but were not on the public version of the voters registration file.

If this policy is going to continue, I feel you need to include these purged voters on the public voters registration file so that candidates are aware of these "unregistered" registered voters. I'm told that the 920 voters deleted from the public file are deceased people and felons that Elections is required to inactivate. It seems that most of these people should have been deleted earlier so they would not appear on the precinct lists that were printed from the 10/17/94 file. Once they show up and vote at a precinct their ballot would go into the box and there would be no way to remove it.

2. VOTERS ASSIGNED TO THE WRONG DISTRICT.

For 1994 there were minor changes in district boundaries. Elections had to reassign some voters to new district/precincts. They made some errors as can be expected since this is a tedious task. Candidates would find these errors when using our walking lists for their door-to-door campaigning. One of the larger errors had the Anchorage Pioneer home in the wrong district. Some candidates got very frustrated when it took multiple calls over a couple months to get Elections to make the corrections. There were 339 such voters including the Pioneer's home who were assigned to new districts between the September and October public files. Another 88 were redistricted after the October file was released. Any of those 443 that voted in the primary were voting for the wrong State House candidates and possibly the wrong State Senate candidates. The same may have been true for the general election for the 88 that were redistricted after October 17. Most of these problems affected Senate District J, where the final vote difference was only 26 votes. The 339 and 88 registered voters are listed in attachments C and D.

3. UNPROCESSED ADDRESS CHANGES.

One of our employees moved to a new district in November 1993. When he went to vote in the April '94 local he had not made an address change so he voted a questioned ballot and requested an address change. When he went back to vote for the primary, his address change had not been made so he again voted a questioned ballot and requested another address change. His State House and State Senate votes were not counted because he was voting where he lived rather than at his old address where the State still had him registered. When he went back in November his address change had still not been made. He again had to vote a questioned ballot and his State House and State Senate votes were again not counted. After some complaining phone calls they finally had his address changed on the November public file. My impression is that by October, the Elections office was buried in work and let some of their work lead slide. During October Elections staff that normally return my phone calls in minutes would take days to get back to me. Not making timely address changes may disenfranchise a voter.

4. INVALID RESIDENCE ADDRESSES.

One of the products we produce for candidates is walking lists for their door-to-door campaigning. It has been my impression that elections do not suppose to accept a registration without a physical residence address. But the walking lists always show up with people registered at post office boxes, private box offices, state office buildings, the federal building, business addresses, vacant lots, non-existent addresses, etc. Some of these conditions Elections could check for easily, others would take a lot of work. Is there any requirement that a registered voter actually resides where they indicate? It seems unfair to a candidate that people who do not live in his district can pick an address to register at and vote in his district. A candidate should be able to notify Elections and have the voter inactivated. Another residence problem group are those that live out of state but are allowed to vote in Alaska as long as they say that they intend to return some day. They get to pick a resident address and they can pick a different address for each election. Again this seems contrary to the notion of having a elected official represent the people that live in his district.

5. DATA ERRORS.

One of the most common complaints that candidates have about the voters file is the inaccuracy of the addresses. Some candidates have us maintain private files for them with corrected addresses. They will do an address correction requested mailing to their constituents. It is normal to have 25% or more of the addresses come back, especially in a military district. I know that many years ago, Elections did an address corrected mailing and then updated mailing addresses from the post office returns. Would it be legal to update a voters residence address and possibly assign him to a new district based on a post office forwarding notice? One solution might be to send an address correction request form to a voter when the post office or a candidate indicates that the voter no longer lives at the old residence address.

6. DATA PROCESSING REVIEW BOARD PROBLEMS.

I was chairman of the Anchorage Data Processing Review Board for the '86, '88, and '90 elections. I agreed to perform that thankless job with miniscule compensation because I wanted to convince myself that the ballot counting process was accurate. And I became convinced that the procedures established were sound. The purpose of the Data Processing Review Board is to be a group of citizens who are knowledgeable about computer processing from different political parties to oversee the computer ballot counting. A major task was to punch every possible ballot configuration and verify that the ballot counting program was accurate.

I have been told some disturbing things about the '94 Data Processing Review Boards that I have not been able to verify. I repeat them to you so you can at least be aware of them.

- a. I was told that director Swanson assigned the elections supervisor in each area to their board. In 1986 we would not let the wife of one of the state programmers serve on the board because we felt it was too much of a conflict. The purpose of the board is to audit the actions of the elections supervisor. How can the elections supervisor audit herself?
- b. I was told that the board did not make up their own test decks.
- c. I was told that director Swanson rejected ballots where multiple punches were made in the same rectangular area on the governor/lieutenant governor race. It takes two punch positions on the ballot to list the governor/lieutenant governor names and party. One of the tests required of the Data Processing Review Board was to verify that if a voter punched either or both of the positions his vote would count. It is my understanding that director Swanson rejected any ballots where both positions were punched in the '94 general.



The House Finance Committee Substitute modifies and makes additions to the State Election Code, AS 15, applicable to voter registration and the administration of state elections.

Bill section 1: The changes proposed to AS 15.07.125 go to the matter of "inactive" registered voters. There are several places where, with respect to names on the master registration list, the term "inactive" seems to take on several meanings depending on the context in which it appears. Registrations, if I understand correctly, may be "active," or "inactive," or the voters' names may be purged. This bill section substantively rewrites AS 15.07.125 to impose the additional requirement that the names of voters that are inactivated are to be maintained on the state's official registration list.

Bill section 2: There is no statute that specifically authorizes purchase of voter registration lists. The Elections Division relies on some combination of administrative regulations to make the lists available for a fee. Proposed AS 15.07.127 would authorize the preparation and distribution of those lists, including all information required to be maintained on the official voter registration list.

Bill section 3 directs the Elections Division Director to purge the registration list of the names of deceased voters at least monthly.

Substantively, **bill section 4** directs revision of that registration list based on receipt of information about convicted felons "promptly."

Bill section 5 removes from AS 15.20.203(d) the responsibility imposed on the regional election supervisors to tell voters why the count of the voter's absentee vote was challenged.

while, at the same time, **bill section 6** shifts that burden to the election division director and allows the director 60 days following certification to provide a more comprehensive explanation about the disposition of that absentee vote.

In like fashion, **bill section 7** removes from AS 15.20.207(d) the responsibility imposed on the regional election supervisors to tell voters why the count of the voter's questioned vote was challenged and, in line with that change, **bill section 8** shifts that burden to the director and allows the director a period of days following certification to provide a more comprehensive explanation about the disposition of that questioned ballot.

Similarly, **bill section 9** requires the director to prepare and provide the same kind of explanation in the event a ballot is only partially counted under the statute authorizing partial counting of cross-district ballots and counting of names of write-in candidates on certain ballots provided to the voter in error.

Bill section 10: For purposes of oversight of punch-card voting and other aspects of computerized elections operations, state law requires the director to appoint a data processing review board. The change made in this section would preclude the director from appointing state employees--especially persons who are subordinates of the director--to that board.

CSHB 211 (FIN) does five things:

First, it requires the names of the inactive voters to be maintained on the official voter registration list.

Currently, the official list used at each polling place contains only the active registered voters. Now, the official list will have to contain the inactive but registered voters as well. By having an official list of inactive but registered voters available at each polling place, people who have not voted within the past two years will be able to vote a regular ballot instead of a questioned ballot. This will eliminate approximately 1500-2000 questioned ballots statewide, possibly more depending upon who decides to vote.

Second, it authorizes the preparation and distribution of the voter registration list and requires the list to include active and inactive voters.

The official list will be made available to the public so any member of any district or political party will be able to obtain both active and inactive registered voters. This will give candidates and political parties the opportunity to contact inactive registered voters prior to an election. The result will probably be more voters reactivating themselves by voting.

Third, It requires the prompt purging of deceased voters and felons

In the 1994 election, seven dead people may have voted. For this reason, HB 211 directs the division of elections to purge the official voter registration list for deceased persons on a monthly basis.

There is a gap of time between sentencing and the conviction of a felon. If the division of elections has not obtained the necessary information from the Dept. of Corrections regarding felony convictions the names are not purged from the official voter list. Potentially, a convicted felon could vote before his/her name is

purged. Section 4 of this bill directs the division of elections to promptly cancel the registration of a person convicted of a felony. After discharge from prison, a person can present proof of unconditional discharge from custody and become a registered voter again.

Fourth, It gives the Div. of Elections' division director the responsibility to provide voters with a comprehensive explanation if their absentee or questioned ballot was rejected or partially rejected.

During the 1994 primary election there were 6,990 questioned ballots statewide. That number does not include totally rejected ballots, because they are not counted as a vote on the official registration list. Of the 6,990 primary questioned ballot voters, 1,640 also voted a questioned ballot in the general election. These voters should have had appropriate corrections made before the general election in order to decrease the chance of partial or complete ballot rejection.

In the last general election there were 14,144 question ballots statewide; of these 5,131 were counted, 7,883 were partially rejected, and 1,129 were totally rejected. The explanations voters received from the Div. of Elections were not clear. The result was, that many voters did not understand why their votes were rejected.

During the last voter district reapportionment, many people who did not move from their homes changed voting districts due to boundary changes. Some of these people were not notified of the change by the Division of Elections. Their votes for their representative and Senator were rejected.

Fifth, it prohibits state employees from membership on the data processing review board.

This provision will avoid any appearance of conflict of interests.

This legislation helps to prevent problems experienced in the last election from reoccurring. I urge your positive support of CSHB 211 (FIN).

Dear Senator Sharp:

As the borough clerk and election supervisor for the Kenai Peninsula Borough, I strongly oppose sections of HB 211.

Section 1 requires all inactive voters to be included in precinct lists. Inactive voters, no matter on what list their name appears, would still be required to vote a questioned ballot. Alaska is a very transient state. The majority of inactive voters no longer reside in the area. Having the names of active and inactive voters on one list would be both cumbersome and confusing at the polls, and, would, without a doubt, lead to inactive voters voting a "regular" ballot as opposed to a "questioned" ballot. I would have no opposition to having a separate list of inactive voters available at the polls, although I cannot see what purpose it would serve.

The provision contained in Section 9 requiring written notification to voters whose ballots were partially counted is pointless. My experience has shown that, with exceptions, voters who don't take the time and trouble to vote at the precinct where they are registered are usually only interested in the "big ticket items" such as the presidential or gubernatorial race or a ballot proposition. When a voters votes out of precinct, they are advised by the poll workers that a portion of their ballot may not be counted. The "big ticket" items are voted statewide and would be counted on the ballots of all qualified voters. That is the main concern of these voters. Alaska is one of the few, perhaps even the only, state which allows cross-precinct voting. I believe funds should be appropriated to educate voters on the importance of voting in the proper precinct. Adding this written notification would mean quite a bit of additional work for the elections offices, but also be discouraging to a voter.

I urge you to look closely at these two sections prior to passing HB 211 out of your committee.
