### Mine rules better but still flawed

The latest agreement between placer miners, government agencies and environmental groups brings water quality regulations, if not down to Earth, then at least into a low-level orbit.

This agreement was about a year in the making. It grew from a proposed out-of-court settlement between the federal Environmental Protection Agency and environmental groups. That settlement, announced in February of 1996, was so foul that Alaska's Department of Environmental Conservation publicly challenged the EPA.

The resulting compromise, discussed at a workshop Tuesday in Fairbanks, brought some reason to the rules, but left plenty to criticize. Environmental groups, represented primarily by the Sierra Club Legal Defense Fund, have agreed not to challenge the EPA's general permits for placer mining if the state finds those permits acceptable. That removes some uncertainty for miners. The environmental groups also agreed to drop a demand that the EPA enforce stream discharge limits for most metals until EPA finishes a 2-year study of whether such limits are even needed in Alaska. That makes sense as well.

But the most bizarre aspect of the EPA's permit—the arsenic standard—still remains. The standard says no one may dump water into "freshwater" rivers and lakes if the dumped water contains more than .18 parts per billion of arsenic. This number has little basis in science; it was developed through a highly questionable extrapolation process. In fact, the EPA, Alaska's DEC, and other state agencies in the United States allow "drinking water" from a well to contain up to 50 ppb of arsenic.

The EPA did make one concession with regard to arsenic rules. The original general permits did not allow consideration of natural arsenic levels in the water that placer miners use. If it came out of a placer mine, the standard applied. In the compromise, background levels can be considered. Also, since arsenic can't be reliably detected below 3 ppb, the EPA won't go after any miners unless the arsenic added to discharge water exceeds that figure.

Unfortunately, the EPA's general permits won't be available to anyone operating in federal conservation areas and on the "wild" parts of wild and scenic rivers. Miners with legitimate claims in these areas need individual permits, requiring more expensive data and detail.

That's overkill. Placer miners today do not muck up the Interior's clearwater streams like they did during the early 1980s. Strict regulations have forced virtually all operations to recycle 100 percent of their water. Only during heavy rainfall do their muddy ponds overflow. So for all intents and purposes, such intermittent overflows are the only discharge to which these regulations will apply. And if those overflows conform to the general permit rules, they will still threaten our wild rivers no more than the average eroding mud bank.

### POSITION PAPER

ON

HB 68

The International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local Union 1547, represents nearly 5,000 men and women throughout the State of Alaska, all of whom are paid an hourly wage in exchange for their work. On behalf of those five-thousand represented Alaskan workers, and indeed all Alaskan workers, represented or not, we would like to state our emphatic opposition to this proposed change in state wage and hour law. To adopt this proposed change would return the Alaskan worker to a pre-twentieth century standard, effectively undoing one-hundred years of progressive reform.

We are especially offended by the concept that, as a voluntary work plan, this change in state law is initiated at the behest of workers. Wage and hour laws were established in response to employer coercion. There is a strong motive for an employer to subtly, or even overtly, suggest workers "voluntarily" give back two hours of overtime per day. One must seriously consider the realistic chances of an employee risking <sup>a</sup> his job by refusing to accommodate <sup>the</sup> his employer and thereby facing the prospect of being replaced by someone a little hungrier who is willing to work under the "voluntary" plan. <sup>That</sup> This is exactly why the provision exists in State law for workers to develop a bona fide voluntary flex-plan within a collective

bargaining agreement. The employee is shielded from coercion by the nature of the collective bargaining process and the mutually agreed upon, negotiated result.

Corporate benefit is the issue at hand in this legislation. We are not convinced ~~in the least~~ that this reduction in compensation is being brought before the Legislature "on behalf" of workers. We are doubtful that any employer would selflessly hire not one, but four lobbyists, to promote legislation purely for the benefit of their workers. The underlying motivation for this legislation is the desire on the part of the employer's to reduce expenses by eliminating a shift and to avoid paying <sup>its</sup> his employees two hours of overtime compensation that <sup>it</sup> he would be entitled to, under current law. The consequence of this legislation, a reduction in shifts results in the exact opposite effect than contemplated as the purpose of overtime statutes; inducing employers to spread employment through the pressure of extra costs<sup>1</sup>.

Fort Knox can, and should, accommodate employee shift and commute concerns within the confines of current Alaska law. Nothing precludes them from adopting a twelve-hour schedule. They, as nearly every other Alaskan employer would be obligated to pay for hours worked, including compensation for overtime.

Following on the heels of the 1996 legislation giving the mining industry a complete rewrite of the limitation on the period of employment in underground mines and granting them two additional hours for work to be performed at the face of a mine<sup>2</sup>, we are concerned that incremental assaults on wage and hour and safety legislation will continue to erode the protections for Alaskan workers that have been built into law.

We urge the committee to reject this shameless assault on Alaskan workers and their right to earn a living wage.

## Proposal would change rules for overtime

■ *Voluntary plan would let surface miners work up to 12 hours without earning overtime*

A bill that would have let many Alaskans work up to 12 hours a day without earning overtime went too far, its sponsor says. He's rewriting the bill two days after it was introduced to make clear it applies only to surface mine workers.

Rep. Gene Theriault, a Fairbanks Republican, said he's co-sponsoring House Bill 69 at the request of miners at the Fort Knox gold mine in his district. They want to work 12-hour shifts with more days off in between than they have on their current eight-hour shift schedule.

The bill would exempt employers from the normal requirement to pay overtime after eight hours, if employers and employees agreed to a "voluntary work plan" requesting that arrangement, and the state approved that plan.

Employers would still be required to pay overtime for work beyond 40 hours a week.

The bill quickly drew criticism from some lawmakers and administration officials who feared it would erode workers' pay in industries other than mining, and that the agreements would not be purely voluntary.

"They're going to be working the same hours and, of course, earning less," said Juneau Sen. Jim Duncan, a Democrat and Senate minority leader.

Theriault said opposition to the bill is not the reason he's rewriting it. He said he never intended it to apply to anyone other than mine workers and he just didn't pay enough attention to the wording of the bill when he introduced it.

Currently Alaska employers, with certain exceptions, have to pay overtime for anything past eight hours worked in a day, even if total hours for the week do not exceed 40.

Theriault said the bill had broad support from workers and management at Fort Knox. Some have a round-trip commute of an hour and a half a day to get to their jobs, he said, and they would prefer to do that commute less often.

Under a schedule proposed if the legislation passes, those employees would work 14 days of 12 hours each every four weeks, instead of 21 eight-hour days every four weeks.

A 12-hour workday would also be more efficient for the company because it would be running two shifts a day, instead of three, Theriault said.

The bill, under proposed changes, would not affect workers at Greens Creek mine on Admiralty Island since ore there is extracted underground, not on the surface, Theriault said.

The state Department of Labor did not support the original version of the bill, said Dwight Perkins, legislative liaison for the department. He said officials there would take another look at it now that the focus is being narrowed.

Duncan and fellow Juneau Democrat, Rep. Kim Eiton, didn't like the original version. Juneau Republican Rep. Bill Hudson said he had no problem with the bill as long as workers and employers agree to the schedule change.

(I did notice the word voluntary) This might be fine for the twenty (20) year olds, but as we grow older few people are physically able to work a twelve (12) hour day in the construction industry. I work with asbestos, hazardous waste, and demolition. I can assure you that safety and quality of work suffer significantly when people work tired. In the industry when safety standards diminish, people die. This affects both of us as I might get sent home in a body bag and you might get exposed to asbestos fibers.

Please reconsider, as this bill could have serious consequences to it.

This letter is being written to express our concerns regarding House Bill #68.

We would like to make it clear that we support the mining industry in this State. We hope their ventures return large profits for their investors and provide good and safe employment for their workers.

We do not think H.B.#68 is a good Bill. We see that there are two issues that need to be addressed. Firstly, we have the employees of the mine who want a 12-hour rotation so they can have more days off in a month. You can't blame a person for that. Secondly, you have an employer who says "okay, however in trade for that we want you to give up your overtime compensation or we will keep you on this current schedule" which is the worst we could possibly arrange for. So, we have 250 people who have signed a petition to give away their overtime if this Legislature sees fit to change state statute. Not being heard from are hundreds of the other mine workers within the State that do not even know HB exists. We are sure many of those people who work long shifts and are getting compensated for their overtime by fair and responsible employers might be more than concerned about changing the overtime laws.

How can this issue be resolved? Is it not possible for this mining company to extract 1,000 oz. gold per day and pay its workers overtime with the present statute intact? Are there other government agencies responsible for the financial burden placed on the mine that could be relieved? Is there some way we can resolve this issue without putting the full burden on the backs of the working men and women? We would surely hope so because we feel this is just the top of the iceberg. All other industries statewide will want this exemption for oil, timber, fish processing, construction and on and on. How can they be denied?

We would urge this committee to not pass this Bill. There are ways to achieve the goals of both the worker and the mining company without changing state statute. This Bill will negatively affect a great number of workers throughout the State. We appreciate your time and consideration on this matter.

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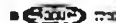




