As House Bill No. 68 now reads I object to it on several levels. The main area is that it is not family oriented, is bad for health (long term), eliminates jobs and is primarily for the convenience of employers (Corporations) in general.

With a worker on 12 hour shifts, there is little or no time for socialization, writing, etc., with family, friends or co-workers. While it is true flexible work weeks can be good for the shorter term but on a more permanent long term schedule 12 hour days are fatiguing enough to be dangerous in many cases. Has or will the legislators give serious thought to safety such as studies or previous accidents due to such long hours?

Since this is currently aimed at the mining industry, no mention is made as to housing and/or travel time. Both of which is of vital concern. That must mean the 12 hour day is in addition to travel, etc., leaving precious little time for rejuvenation from fatigue or relaxation not to mention family. How far is housing from any job site?

If this change to Alaska Law takes place, who is to say that other industries will not attempt to change employment practices in the same manner. These changes definitely result in less employees (less shifts) which of course is beneficial mainly to the employer instead of employee. Once jobs are lost they will be difficult to recoup if ever.

Another point to consider: What types of labor organizations will be effected? Union jobs which can include policeman, firemen, nurses, construction workers, aircraft controllers, train engineers, conductors or whoever can have flexible hours. Non-union jobs such as food workers, fish cannery employees, retail clerks, etc., can or will be effected simply because they have less support for their cause.

This bill was initiated for the benefit of Fort Knox Mine of Fairbanks, operated by Fairbanks Gold Mining Inc., a subsidiary of Amax Gold Inc. For some strange reason the current legislature is intent on getting this bill passed. I wonder why? All articles published to this date I feel give that impression.

This letter is being written to express our concerns regarding House Bill #68.

We would like to make it clear that we support the mining industry in this State. We hope their ventures return large profits for their investors and provide good and safe employment for their workers.

We do not think H.B.#68 is a good Bill. We see that there are two issues that need to be addressed. Firstly, we have the employees of the mine who want a 12-hour rotation so they can have more days off in a month. You can't blame a person for that. Secondly, you have an employer who says "okay, however in trade for that we want you to give up your overtime compensation or we will keep you on this current schedule" which is the worst we could possibly arrange for. So, we have 250 people who have signed a petition to give away their overtime if this Legislature sees fit to change state statute. Not being heard from are hundreds of the other mine workers within the State that do not even know HB exists. We are sure many of those people who work long shifts and are getting compensated for their overtime by fair and responsible employers might be more than concerned about changing the overtime laws.

How can this issue be resolved? Is it not possible for this mining company to extract 1,000 oz. gold per day and pay its workers overtime with the present statute intact? Are there other government agencies responsible for the financial burden placed on the mine that could be relieved? Is there some way we can resolve this issue without putting the full burden on the backs of the working men and women? We would surely hope so because we feel this is just the top of the iceberg. All other industries statewide will want this exemption for oil, timber, fish processing, construction and on and on. How can they be denied?

We would urge this committee to not pass this Bill. There are ways to achieve the goals of both the worker and the mining company without changing state statute. This Bill will negatively affect a great number of workers throughout the State. We appreciate your time and consideration on this matter.
