GAS GENERATION IN COAL

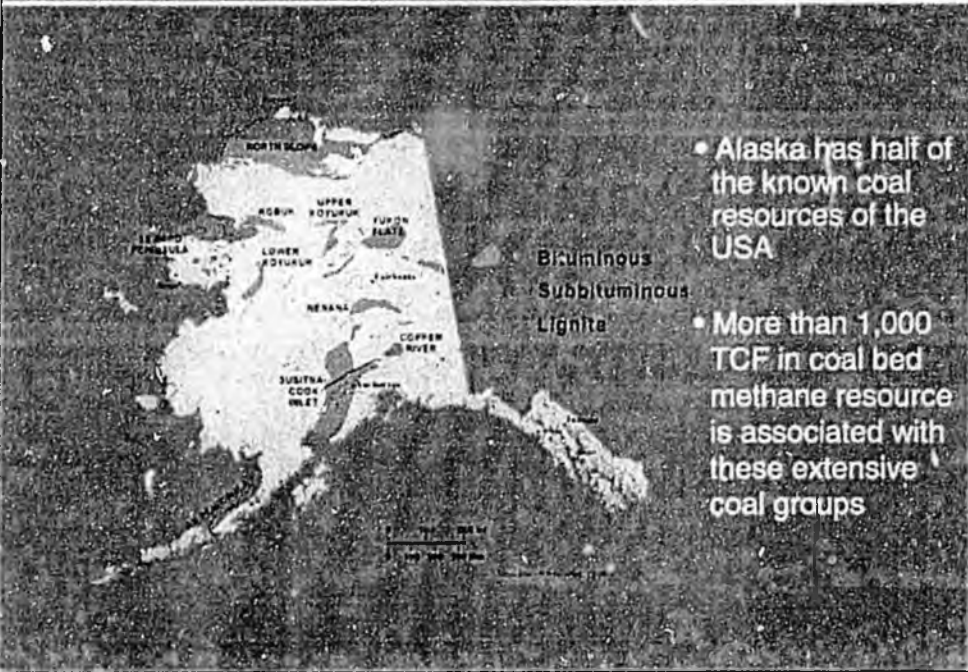


PROCESSES IN THE TRANSPORT OF COALBED METHANE GAS



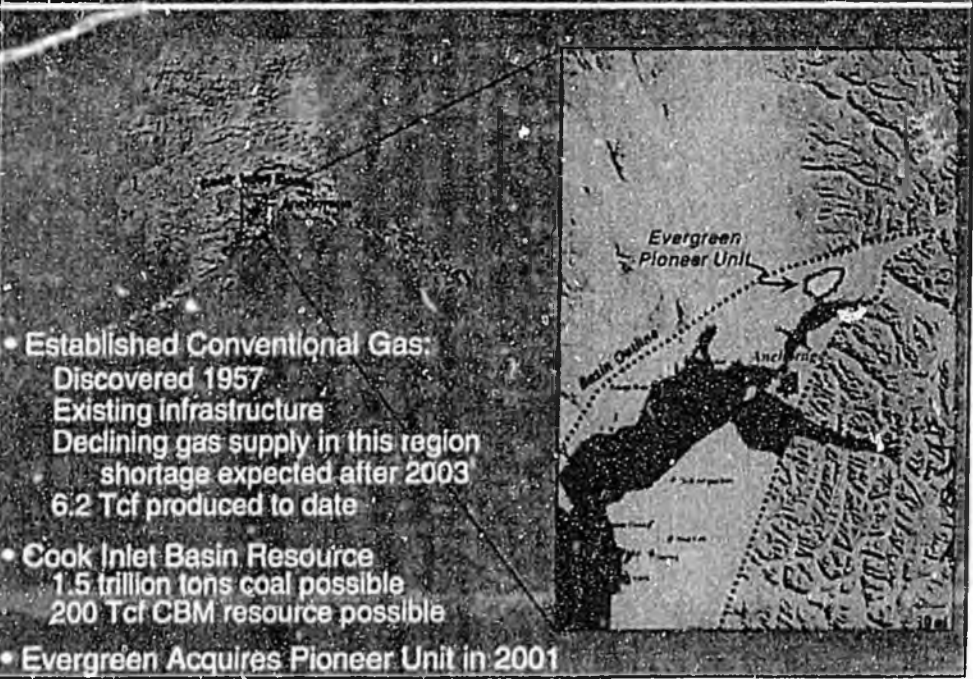

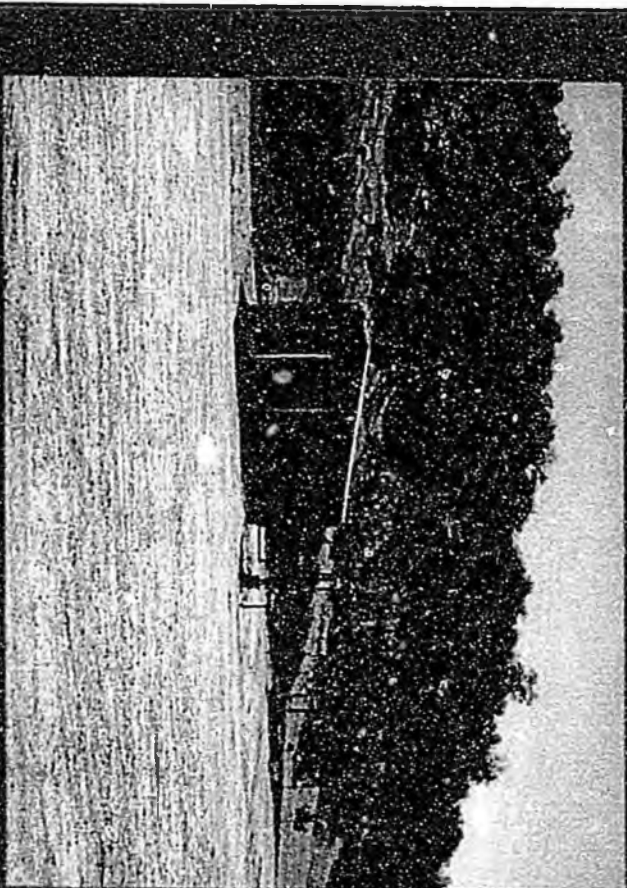


Electric Well Pump
