

Allowing Ketchikan to obtain a \$1,200,000 windfall in federal forest receipt funds with no resulting obligation to provide any additional public or educational services to the 4,700 square miles of uninhabited land KGB is seeking to annex while causing irreparable harm to regional communities and school districts on Prince of Wales and Annette Islands not only in the loss of forest receipt revenues, but Payment in Lieu of Taxes-PILT revenues, the impact of PILT revenue loss will be immediate. Prince of Wales districts will lose about one half of their PILT funding if the annexation is approved.

Prior to permitting the Ketchikan annexation to become law, the state legislature must appoint an independent committee to review the very real perception that there has been a conflict of interest surrounding the Local Boundary Commission-LBC decision as it concerns a former high ranking LBC staff who was influential in making staff recommendations to the LBC regarding this current recommendation in favor of Ketchikan's annexation application which is in direct opposition to, and overturned the 1999 annexation decision, prior to securing a five year contract at a six figure salary with the Ketchikan Gateway Borough as the new Ketchikan city manager.

This petition is in response to Annette Island School District's plea to all people of Metlakatla to OPPOSE annexation of our school system and that of other school districts on Prince of Wales Island. I am putting this petition around town in coordination with Mr. Brett Agenbroad, Superintendent of AISD. Our school district has officially expressed its dismay regarding this issue, but it will take a huge effort by Metlakatla citizens to express our loud opposition to this measure.

## Sponsor Statement

### SB 72 – COMMUNITY REVENUE SHARING

SB 72 establishes a sustainable revenue sharing program based on the owner-state concept. The resources of the state belong to all Alaskans. Cities and boroughs were formed by the state as political subdivisions to provide services to the people. Without revenue sharing, the entire cost of basic services is borne by local taxpayers.

Skyrocketing fuel and retirement system costs and inflation, in conjunction with severe cuts in revenue sharing over the past several years have local governments scrambling to continue providing even basic services such as snow removal and road maintenance, public safety, and the education of our children.

SB 72 provides a means for sustainable revenue sharing in order to allow communities to continue providing basic services. SB 72 would allow the legislature to allocate 3% of certain natural resource revenues or up to \$50,000,000 for community revenue sharing every year. Basing revenue sharing on the state's annual income allows for the flexibility needed to continue the program during lean years, when state revenue is down.

Without consistent, dependable revenue sharing, provision of basic services will continue to decline. Some small communities have already closed their doors. SB 72 provides the tool to solve the problem of helping local governments fund basic services.
