Mr. SPARKMAN, from the Committee on Banking, Housing and Urban Affairs, reported the following bill; which was read twice and ordered to be placed on the calendar

A BILL

To consolidate, simplify, and improve laws relative to housing and housing assistance, to provide Federal assistance in support of community development activities, and for other purposes.

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That this Act may be cited as the "Housing and Community
4 Development Act of 1974".

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska remote housing program;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Ch. 212, SLA 1968 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 1. In anticipation of a federal appropriation of \$10,000,000
11 to the people of Alaska by the federal government under Title 10, Section
12 1004, Public Law 89-754, 80 Stat. 1285 (1966), the Department of
13 Administration is authorized to make available to the agency designated by
14 the Governor under ch. 93, SLA 1967, the sum of \$1,000,000 as the state's
15 share in financing the cost of preparing, administering and implementing
16 the Alaska Native Housing Program authorized by Title 10, Section 1004,
17 Public Law 89-754, 80 Stat. 1285 (1966) and implemented by ch. 93, SLA 1967.
18 However, if the United States Congress fails to appropriate at least
19 \$1,000,000 in any fiscal year to the Alaska Native Housing Program, the
20 Department of Administration is authorized to make available to the agency
21 designated by the governor under ch. 93, SLA 1967 an amount up to \$1,000,000
22 for that fiscal year in order to assure if possible a total remote housing
23 program of up to \$1,000,000 for each fiscal year. [HOWEVER, IF LESS THAN
24 \$1,000,000 IS GRANTED TO THE PEOPLE OF ALASKA BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT UNDER
25 THIS PROGRAM, THE PORTION OF STATE FUNDS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE BY THE
26 DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION UNDER THIS ACT SHALL BE REDUCED BY THE SAME
27 PERCENTAGE AS THE AMOUNT OF FEDERAL FUNDS GIVEN DIFFERS FROM THE \$10,000,000
28 AUTHORIZED.]

29 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
