## CHAPTER I.

(H. B. NO. 2.)

AN ACT to extend the elective franchise to women in the Territory of Alaska:

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That in all elections which are now, or may hereafter be authorized by law in the Territory of Alaska, or any sub-division or municipality thereof, the elective franchise is hereby extended to such women as have the qualifications of citizenship required of male electors. Suffrage extended to women

Approved, March 21, 1913.

## CHAPTER 2.

(S. B. NO. 4.)

AN ACT in relation to legal holidays and repealing Sections 716 and 717 of Chapter Seventy-one, Title II, of the Code of Civil Procedure for Alaska.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The following days are legal holidays, namely: Sunday; the first day of January, commonly called New Year's Day; the fourth day of July; the twenty-second day of February; the first Monday in September, commonly called Labor Day; the eighteenth day of Legal holidays:
