

CHAPTER 16.

(H. B. NO. 36.)

AN ACT to amend Section Two Hundred and Ninety-nine of the Code of Civil Procedure of Alaska. (Compiled Laws of Alaska, Sec. 1131.)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska :

Section 1. That, Section Two Hundred and Ninety-nine of Title Two, Chapter Thirty-one, of the Act of June 6, 1900, entitled "An Act making further provision for a civil government for Alaska and for other purposes" be amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 299.—Order to Examine Garnishee: Whenever the marshal, with an execution against the property of the judgment debtor, shall apply to any person or officer mentioned in subdivision three of section one hundred and forty for the purpose of levying on any property therein mentioned, such person or officer shall forthwith give to the marshal a certificate in the manner prescribed in section one hundred and forty-three. If such person or officer refuses to do so, or if the certificate be unsatisfactory to the plaintiff in the writ, he may in like manner have the order prescribed in such section against such person or officer. Thereafter the proceeding upon such order shall be conducted in the manner prescribed from section one hundred and fifty-two to section one hundred and sixty-one, inclusive."
