

CHAPTER 3.

(S. B. NO. 12.)

AN ACT to repeal the act of Congress, entitled, "An Act to Authorize the Appointment of Road Overseers and to Create Road Districts in the District of Alaska, and for Other Purposes." 33 Statutes at Large, Chapter 1629, Page 391, approved April 27, 1904, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That certain act of Congress, entitled "An Act to authorize the appointment of road overseers and to create road districts in the District of Alaska, and for other purposes," 33 Statutes at Large, Chapter 1629, approved April 27, 1904, is hereby repealed.

Road districts
and overseers
abolished

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 4.

(S. B. NO. 14.)

AN ACT to prevent the desecration of the flag of the United States, and to provide a punishment for carrying flags in public parades or flying them from buildings under certain conditions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Any person who, in any manner, for exhibition or display puts or causes to be placed any inscription, design, device, symbol, portrait, name, advertisement, words, character, marks or notice whatever upon any flag or ensign of the United States, or Territorial
