

CHAPTER 41.

(H. B. NO. 90.)

AN ACT to amend chapter 2, of the Penal Code of Alaska by adding to said chapter an additional section to be numbered section 31.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

That Chapter two of the Penal Code of Alaska be amended by adding an additional section to read as follows:

Section 31. Any person who shall wilfully and maliciously instigate, make, circulate, or transmit to another or others any false statements derogatory to the financial condition or affecting the solvency or financial standing of any bank, banking institution or trust company doing business in this Territory, or who shall wilfully and maliciously counsel, aid, procure, or induce another to start, transmit, or circulate any such statement or rumor, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
