

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 11.

Be it resolved, by the Senate of the Territory of Alaska, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Governor be, and he is, requested to return to the Senate, Senate Bill No. 55, with reference to the creation of a Mining Commission and Bureau, for the reason that there is a clerical error in the enrollment of the Bill, which has challenged the attention of the Governor and raises in his mind an objection to the Bill, which difficulty can be removed by amendment, exactly in accordance with the purpose for which the Bill was offered.

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 12.

Resolved by the Senate of the Territory of Alaska, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Committees on Engrossment and Enrollment of the two Houses be authorized to correct the Enrolled Bill of Senate, No. 55, entitled: "An Act to create a mining commission, which shall have charge and the management of the Bureau known as the Mining Bureau; defining the powers of the Commission and the purposes of the Bureau," by striking out the word "no" in line 7, Section 5, page 3, of the bill, and inserting in lieu thereof the word "any."
