CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT

[H. B. 15.]

To compensate P. Wilberforce, M.D., for professional services rendered in preventing an epidemic of smallpox within the Territory of Alaska, and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the Treasury of Alaska, the sum of Four Hundred Dollars, for the benefit of P. Wilberforce, M. D., as full compensation for the professional services and efforts of said Wilberforce in preventing an epidemic of smallpox at Hoonah, Alaska, during the months of May and June, 1914.

Appropriation to P. Wilberforce, M. D. for professional services.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect and become effective from and after its passage and approval.

Emergency clause

Approved, March 16, 1915.

CHAPTER 2.

AN ACT

[H. B. 23.]

To make appropriation for a deficiency, and to enable the Secretary of Alaska to meet certain contingent expenses.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

That there be, and hereby is appropriated, out of any money in the General Fund of the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, the sum of
