

CHAPTER 46.

AN ACT

[H. B. 93.]

To amend Section 9, Chapter 32, of Alaska Session Laws for the year 1913, entitled "An Act to establish Juvenile Courts, to provide for the care of dependent children, to create children's guardians in Alaska, and for other purposes" and to re-enact and ratify all other provisions of said Act.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 9, Chapter 32, of Alaska Ses- Sec. 9, Ch. 32,

1913, amended sion Laws for the year 1913, entitled: "An Act to establish Juvenile Courts, to provide for the care of dependent children, to create children's guardians in Alaska, and for other purposes", be amended to read as follows:

Section 9. The judges of the Juvenile Courts herein When Juvenile
Courts to act. provided for shall hear and examine all cases relating to children under this Act on the complaint of any parent, guardian, school teacher, trustee, truant officer, or any other reliable person; and the judges of such Juvenile Courts and witnesses who may be called before same shall receive the same fees and compensation as may be provided for the trial of misdemeanors before a Justice of the Peace, and said fees and compensation shall be paid by the Territory of Alaska.

It shall be the duty of the United States Marshal, or any Deputy United States Marshal, to serve any regularly issued process of said court.

The Juvenile Courts provided hereunder shall issue a certified copy of all the judgments giving any child under the provisions of this Act, such certified copy of the judgment shall be sufficient authority for the person or institution to whom the child may have been committed to hold said child.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared and this Emergency
clause. Act shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
