

Therefore,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska :

Section 1. That the wild native Forget-me-not is hereby made, designated and declared to be the Territorial flower and floral emblem of the Territory of Alaska.

So the emblem of Alaska is the blue Forget-me-not.

CHAPTER 11.

AN ACT

(S. B. 54)

To prohibit the advertising of intoxicating liquors for sale or gift and to fix penalties for the violation thereof

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska :

Section 1. That on and after January 1, 1918, it shall be unlawful for any person, association or corporation, either directly or indirectly, to advertise intoxicating liquors in the Territory for sale or gift, in any newspaper, periodical, circular, hand-bill or price list, or on any sign, sign-board, bill-board, bulletin-board, or in any manner whatsoever; or for any owner, officer or person in charge of any newspaper, periodical, sign, sign-board, bill-board, bulletin-board, printing office, advertising agency or publicity bureau, or any other person, to publish or distribute any matter in the Territory which either directly or indirectly advertises intoxicating liquors for sale or gift; or for any person to place a sign, sign-board, or bulletin-board bearing an advertisement of intoxicating liquors upon the public lands of said Territory.

Advertising intoxicating liquors for sale or gift prohibited.

Section 2. That any person violating any provisions of this Act shall upon proof thereof be punished by a fine of not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars nor more than Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars or by imprisonment not less than ten days nor more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Penalty.
