

CHAPTER 13

AN ACT

(S. B. 73)

Creating a fund in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, to be used for the purpose of detecting crime, and declaring an emergency therefore.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Fund created for detection of crime.

Section 1. That there be, and hereby is, created a fund out of any monies of the Territory of Alaska, now in the Territorial Treasury, or which shall hereafter come into the Territorial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of detecting crime in the Territory of Alaska

\$10,000 appropriated.

Section 2. That the Territorial Treasurer shall be, and hereby is, empowered, authorized and required to set aside, out of any monies of the Territory of Alaska, now in the Territorial Treasury, or which shall hereafter come into the Territorial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for the purpose set forth in Section One of this Act.

Fund to be controlled by governor and how disbursed.

Section 3. That the fund created by this Act shall be under the sole supervision and control of the Governor of the Territory, and shall be by him disbursed through the Territorial Treasurer upon vouchers, in duplicate, properly signed, for the purpose set forth in Section One of this Act.

Emergency.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval
