

CHAPTER 2.

AN ACT

(H. B. 30)

To make an appropriation for defense of the Territory, and declaring an emergency to exist.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
for military de-
fense, etc.

Section 1. That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) out of the monies in the General Fund of the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be expended under the direction of the Governor of Alaska to be used by him for purposes of defense of the Territory, and for military and other purposes connected therewith.

Emergency
declared.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall, therefore, take effect, and all monies appropriated hereunder, become expendable immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 3.

AN ACT

(H. B. 41)

To provide for payment of allowances of certain aged pioneers under the provisions of Chapter 64, Session Laws, 1915, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
for allowances
for Pioneers.

Section 1. That there be, and hereby is appropriated from the General Fund of the Territorial Treasury to be expended by the Board of Trustees of the Alaska Pioneer's Home, the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the payment of allowances for the quarter beginning April 1, 1917.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this bill shall take effect and the money herein ap-
