CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT

(H. B. 36)

To make an appropriation for constructing, repairing and maintaining trails, roads and bridges throughout the Territory of Alaska, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska :

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated, from the monies from the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, for constructing, repairing and maintaining trails, roads and bridges throughout the Territory of Alaska the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00), Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00), to be immediately available, and Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) on March 1, 1918. The sum hereby appropriated shall be set apart and constitute a separate fund for the above purposes, and shall not be expended for any other purposes.

Appropriation for constructing, repairing and maintaining trails, roads and bridges.

Section 2. The fund appropriated in Section 1, of this Act shall be divided, and apportioned equally among the four road districts or divisions established by Chapter 27 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1915.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after May 15, 1917.
