

## CHAPTER 46.

## AN ACT

(H. B. 82)

Authorizing the Attorney-General of the Territory of Alaska to appear in and assist in the prosecution of crimes and misdemeanors defined by the Territorial Legislature.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the Attorney General of the Territory of Alaska shall have the power, whenever in his judgment the interests of the Territory demand it, to appear in and assist in the prosecution of any criminal case where the offense charged is a violation of an act of the Territorial Legislature.

Attorney-General to assist in criminal prosecutions, when.

Section 2. The authority herein granted shall extend to all proceedings both in the courts of Alaska and in the appellate court and whenever in any case above mentioned the United States is allowed the right of review by Writ of Error, the Attorney General of the Territory may perfect the appeal in case of the refusal of the United States Attorney so to do.

Extends to proceedings in all courts.

## CHAPTER 47.

## AN ACT

(S. B. 84)

Authorizing the Governor of Alaska to maintain a Bureau of Publicity, and providing moneys for the conduct of the business thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the Governor of the Territory of Alaska shall maintain a Bureau of Publicity which Bureau shall have the following duties, to-wit:

Bureau of Publicity authorized and purposes stated.

(A) To aid prospectors, settlers and investors by the collection, compilation, publication and distribution of accurate information about the mineral and agricul-
