

CHAPTER 68.

AN ACT

(H. B. 89)

Appropriating the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars, (\$100,000.00) for the defense of the Territory, providing for the expenditure thereof and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.) is hereby appropriated from the monies in the Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and set apart and reserved as an emergency fund for the defense of the Territory.

Section 2. Such fund, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be expended in the discretion and under the direction of the Governor of Alaska for the defense or relief of the Territory in connection with pressing contingencies, directly and immediately chargeable to war conditions and none other.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 69.

AN ACT

(S. B. 70)

To make uniform the laws of partnership.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Part 1.

Section 1. (Name of Act) This act may be cited as Uniform Partnership Act.

Section 2. (Definition of Terms) In this Act, "Court" includes every court and judge having jurisdiction in the case.

"Business" includes every trade, occupation, or profession.
