CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT

(H. B. 4)

To extend the period covered by the appropriation for the support of schools in incorporated towns and in incorporated school districts, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the period covered by the appropriation for the support of schools in incorporated towns and in incorporated school districts, provided for in Chapter 73, Session Laws of Alaska, 1917, entitled: "An Act to make appropriations for the expense of the Territory of Alaska for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1917, and for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1918, and for the quarter ending March 31, 1919, and declaring an emergency," is hereby extended to cover the period ending at the close of the school year, June 30, 1919.

School appropriation 1917 extended to cover school year.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
