

CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT

(S. B. 75)

To amend Section 2 of Senate Bill No. 10, being an Act entitled: "AN ACT providing for the establishment of fish hatcheries, for the improvement of salmon spawning streams, the protection and care of the same and the spawning beds therein, the carrying on of research work and the artificial propagation connected therewith, creating a Territorial Fish Commission and prescribing its duties, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency," approved May 1, 1919, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Amending Section 2, Senate Bill No. 10

Section 1. Section 2 of Senate Bill No. 10, approved May 1, 1919, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Appointment members Fish Commission

Section 2. There is hereby created a Territorial Fish Commission consisting of five members, of which the Governor shall be the Chairman and Senator John Ronan, Senator J. R. Heckman, Representative I. Sowerby and Representative John Noon, shall be constituted a committee to nominate to the Governor the names of the other four members for his consideration and approval, and who, when so approved by the Governor, shall become members of the Commission for the term ending March 31, 1921. The Governor shall fill by appointment, any vacancies in the Commission that may occur before the next meeting of the Legislature, and thereafter shall appoint, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate all appointees for the succeeding term of two years.

Governor may fill vacancies

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
