The oath to the vouchers herein provided for shall be taken and made before such United States Commissioner, and such vouchers shall be paid by the Territorial Treasurer, only after such vouchers have been passed upon by the Governor as to the necessity of relief and rescue party for which expenses related in such vouchers was incurred, the reasonableness of such expenses and proper audit of such vouchers; and the Governor shall promulgate rules and regulations for the guidance of United States Commissioners, governing their authorization of such rescue and relief parties and of the expenses so incurred."

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and the (this) Act shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 42.

### AN ACT

(H. B. 45)

To pay for services rendered, and reimburse for expenses incurred, by Dr. Joseph A. Silverman at Kodiak, Afognak and Ouzinka, Alaska, from September 6th, 1913, to March 1st, 1914, under the provisions of Chapter 42, Session Laws of 1913, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriating

Section 1. That the sum of Nine Hundred Dollars (\$900.00) be, and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to pay Dr. Joseph A. Silverman for the services he rendered and expenses incurred, under the provisions of Chapter 42 of the Session Laws of 1913, in treating the sick, quarantining, fumigating houses, etc., at the time of an epidemic of measles at Kodiak, Afog-

nok and Ouzinka, Alaska, from September 6th., 1913, to March 1st, 1914.

Section 2. The Treasurer of Alaska is hereby directed to draw a warrant for the sum of Nine Hundred Dollars (\$900.00), payable to Dr. Joseph A. Silverman, and deliver the same to him immediately after the passage and approval of this Act, in full payment for said services. Authorizing issuance of warrant

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval. Emergency

## CHAPTER 43.

### AN ACT

(H. B. 58)

Directing the Attorney General to prepare an Income Tax Law.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The Attorney General is hereby directed to draft an Act for the levying of an annual income tax in the Territory of Alaska and he shall make such investigations as are necessary to determine the amount of taxable incomes in the Territory, the proper rate of taxation thereon, and the graduation of such taxation. He shall examine and compare the laws of the different states and of the Federal Government providing for income taxes and from all information obtainable cause an Act suitable to the needs of the Territory to be drafted and presented to the next Legislature of the Territory of Alaska for introduction. Attorney General to draft and submit an income tax law to next Legislature, after investigation
