

House Concurrent Resolutions

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, the Senate concurring, that a joint session of the House and Senate of the said Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, be held in the Hall of the House at two o'clock in the afternoon of Wednesday, the fifth day of March, A. D. 1919, for the purpose of receiving the message of the Governor of the Territory of Alaska.

Adopted by the House March 4, 1919.

Concurred in by the Senate, March 5, 1919.

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 2

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring, that a joint committee, to consist of the three members of the Committee on Printing and Purchasing of the House and the three members of the Committee on Printing and Purchasing of the Senate, meet in joint conference to discuss the question of contingent expenses and printing for the coming session, the time to be set by the chairman of the respective committees.

Adopted by the House March 7, 1919.

Concurred in by the Senate, March 8, 1919.

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, the Senate concurring, that the Senate Committee on Rules and the House Committee on Rules, form a Joint Committee of the two bodies of the Legislature, for purpose of drawing and submitting to each of the two bodies of the Legislature, Joint Rules to govern both bodies during the current session, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, pending the report of the said Joint Committee on Rules, the joint rules of the 1917 session shall govern the Senate and House in the transaction of joint business.
