HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring, that the House Committee on Transportation, Commerce and Navigation, and the Senate Committee on Taxation and Transportation be, and the same are hereby authorized and directed, to hold joint meetings and hearings on Senate Bill No. 25 and House Bill No. 19, and that they be required to submit to each body of the Legislature a statement of their findings and their recommendations of these bills.

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 6

WHEREAS, the daily journal of the House and Senate for May 1st has not been read or approved, and as the validity of all measures passed by the Legislature on that date depends upon the correct journal entries being made at each stage of their consideration:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House and Senate concurring, that the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House, in conjunction with the Secretary of the Senate and Chief Clerk of the House, be authorized, after the close of the Session, to revise and arrange said journals in proper and correct order and sign same, and that said President of the Senate and Speaker of the House be allowed the same salary as they are now receiving, as members of the Legislature, for a period of time not to exceed ten days.
