We are far away and relatively of little importance, but we wish to contribute our mite to the noble endeavor, by sending a word of cheer to President Wilson and former President Taft and to all who are so faithfully laboring with them to the end that America may fulfil its destiny as the light of the world and the hope of the ages. God speed them in the noble work in which they are engaged.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That these resolutions be spread upon the Journal of this house, and copies thereof be sent to the President of the United States, and to former President Taft, and to the Senate and House of Representatives at Washington.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Committee on Ways and Means be, and the same hereby is, instructed to include the above item in the General Appropriation Bill.

#### HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 7

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Alaska Territorial Legislature, the Senate concurring, that:

The Treasurer of the Territory is hereby authorized to transfer Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$11,000.00) from the Cur-

rent School Fund to the General Fund, to supplement the appropriation for the support of schools outside of incorporated towns; and

The Treasurer of the Territory is further authorized to transfer Two Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-four and nine one-hundredths Dollars (\$2,364.09) from the Fisheries Fund, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 52, Session Laws of 1913, to the General Fund for general Territorial purposes; and

The Treasurer of the Territory is further authorized to transfer any balances remaining in the Fund for the Relief and Rescue of Lost Persons, the Fund for Primary Elections, and the Fund for Detection of Crime, to the General Fund.
