

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring, that one thousand copies of Senate Bill No. 65 be ordered printed and distributed under the direction of the Banking Board to all banks in the Territory, to Chambers of Commerce, civic bodies, fraternal orders, labor organizations, attorneys, and business men, and that they be requested to communicate to said Banking Board their views as to whether or not,

1st. Such a law should be enacted with their reasons for or against the same.

2nd. Amendments should be made to Senate Bill No. 65 and in what particular.

The Governor shall submit all correspondence and suggestions received by the Banking Board, together with his recommendations thereon to the Legislature at its next regular session.

Adopted by the Senate April 26, 1919.
