

upkeep of the same and for the sale of wood, coal and fuel therefrom at cost, or at such reasonable advance above cost as may by it be determined by ordinance or resolution; and also establish, maintain, control and operate lighthouse plants, and to fix the rates therefor and to take such action by ordinance, resolution or otherwise as may be necessary to protect or preserve the life, health, safety or well-being of the people in the town and to publish all ordinances."

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 16.

AN ACT

[H. B. 24]

To authorize the entertainment of the President of the United States and the Secretary of the Interior on their visit to Alaska, and to appropriate the money therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the Governor of the Territory is hereby authorized to make all arrangements for the entertainment of the President of the United States and the Secretary of the Interior upon their visit here, and to pay for the same the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) or so much thereof as may be needed for said purpose, and for that purpose there is hereby appropriated the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) out of the moneys not otherwise appropriated.
