

CHAPTER 24.

AN ACT

[S. B. 51]

To amend Section 2, Chapter 53, Session Laws of Alaska, 1919.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 2, Chapter 53, Session Laws of Alaska, 1919, be amended to read as follows:

Section 2. No agent or employee of any telephone or electric light company shall remove any instrument or meter or disconnect any wire connected therewith without first notifying the owner, agent or tenant of the building or room wherein such instrument or meter is installed; provided that a notice in writing of the intention to remove any such instrument or meter or to disconnect any wire so connected, shall be sufficient if delivered to the owner, agent or tenant of such building or room before such removal or disconnection, or in case of the absence of such owner, agent or tenant, either by depositing such notice in the post-office properly addressed with postage prepaid, or by posting in a conspicuous place upon such building or room 24 hours before such removal or disconnection; nor shall any agent or employee of any telephone or electric light company enter any building or room to examine, remove or disconnect any instrument or meter without first announcing his presence to the occupants thereof. That any person violating the provisions of the within section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.00) or by imprisonment not to exceed thirty days in the Federal jail, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.
