

CHAPTER 26.

AN ACT

[S. B. 34]

To provide for signing bills of exceptions by other than a trial judge.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That in the absence of any district judge of the Territory of Alaska from the division to which he is assigned and in which division he is the district judge, a bill of exceptions may be signed, settled and allowed by any judge from any other division of the Territory of Alaska presiding over the court in the division where a cause has been tried, in the manner provided for in Section 953 of the Revised Statutes of the United States as amended by the Act of June 5th, 1900, paragraph 1 (Section 1590 Compiled Statutes U. S. 1916).

Bills of Exception may be signed by other than trial judge.

CHAPTER 27.

AN ACT

[S. B. 42]

To provide that fees, licenses, taxes, or other money received by any officer of the Territory, and that fees, licenses, taxes or other money belonging to the Territory of Alaska received by any officer of the United States shall be paid to the Treasurer, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Every officer, board, commission or bureau authorized by the laws of the Territory of Alaska to collect or receive any fees, licenses, taxes or other money, and every officer, board, commission or bureau of the United States authorized by law to collect any

All moneys collected to be paid into Treasury.

fees, licenses, taxes, or other money belonging to the Territory of Alaska, shall account for and pay such fees, licenses, taxes or other money to the Treasurer of the Territory and the same shall be covered into the General Fund.

Salaries and expenses to be paid from appropriation.

Section 2. The salaries and expenses of all officers, boards, commissions and bureaus established by the laws of the Territory shall be paid from appropriations made for that purpose, as other expenses of the Territory are paid.

Emergency.

Section 3. An emergency is declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately on its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 28.

AN ACT

[S. B. 16]

To amend Chapter 48, Session Laws of 1913, relating to Banking Corporations, by amending Section 25 thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

That Section 25, Chapter 48, Session Laws of 1913, be amended to read as follows:

Bank deposits in name of two persons, payable to either.

“Section 25. When a deposit has been made, or shall hereafter be made, in any bank or any trust company doing a banking business in this Territory in the names of two or more persons, payable to either, or payable to either or the survivor, such deposit, or any part thereof, or any interest or dividend thereon, may be paid, to either of said persons, whether the other or others be living or not; and the receipt or acquittance of the person so paid shall be a valid and sufficient release and discharge to the bank for any payment so made.”
