

same manner as the salaries of other Territorial officials are paid, and shall be in lieu of the fees now allowed by law for the collection of license taxes; and all fees, licenses and taxes from whatever source collected, shall be paid by the Secretary into the treasury and covered into the general fund of the Territory; provided, the salary of the present incumbent of the office of Secretary shall be Twenty-five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.00) for the year nineteen hundred and twenty-one, including fees already collected, and thereafter at the rate of Twenty-five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.00) per annum, payable monthly, as the salaries of other Territorial officers are paid, and shall be in full compensation for his services as a member of Territorial Boards and for all other services under the laws of the Territory. Proviso.

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## CHAPTER 34.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 20]

To provide punishment for the breaking, cutting away, injuring or destroying dams, ditches, intakes, gates, hydrants, pipe lines, flumes, canals or power houses of any public or private water or power system.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That if any person shall wilfully break, cut away, injure or destroy any dam, ditch, intake, gate, hydrant, pipe line, flume, canal or power house of any public or private water or power system or power plant, such person shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One Thousand Dollars Breaking dams, etc., a misdemeanor.

(\$1,000) or imprisonment in the Federal jail not more than one (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court.

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## CHAPTER 35.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 43]

To extend the period covered by the appropriation for the support of schools in incorporated towns and in incorporated school districts, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the period covered by the appropriation for the support of schools in incorporated towns and in incorporated school districts, provided for in Chapter 36, Session Laws of Alaska, 1919, entitled: "An Act to make appropriations for the expenses of the Territory of Alaska, for the last three-quarters of the fiscal year 1919, beginning April 1 and ending December 31, for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1920, and for the quarter ending March 31, 1921, and declaring an emergency," is hereby extended to cover the period ending at the close of the school year, June 30, 1921.

Appropriation of schools extended to cover period of 1921 school year.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
