

CHAPTER 8.

AN ACT

[H. B. 7]

Making an appropriation for the Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation.

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated from the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, the sum of Forty-one Thousand Dollars (\$41,000) to the Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines, to be expended by such corporation in the maintenance and conduct of the college established by Chapter Sixty-two (62) of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1917, during the school years of 1921-1922 and 1922-1923. The Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines may expend Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000) of this appropriation in the construction of necessary additional buildings.

Amount for additional buildings from appropriation.

Segregation of amount appropriated.

Section 2. That out of the sum hereby appropriated, Thirty-one Thousand Dollars (\$31,000) thereof shall be turned over to the Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines whenever requested by the Board of Regents of said corporation during the calendar year of 1921, and the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) during the calendar year of 1922; PROVIDED, that not more than Twenty-one Thousand Dollars (\$21,000) of the moneys hereby appropriated shall be used for buildings and equipments for said school.

Emergency.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
