

CHAPTER 100.

AN ACT

[H. B. 52]

To appropriate three thousand (\$3,000.00) dollars for a preliminary survey to determine the feasibility of a tramway or wagon road over the Portage from Unalakleet to Kaltag, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska :

Preliminary
survey of Port-
age from Un-
alakleet to Kal-
tag authorized.

Section 1. That the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners is hereby authorized and directed to engage a competent man to conduct a preliminary survey over the Portage from Unalakleet to Kaltag for the purpose of determining the feasibility and desirability of constructing a tramway or wagon road over the said Portage. Such person shall have authority to employ one or more assistants in carrying out the work.

Report to be
made to
Legislature.

Section 2. The Territorial Board of Road Commissioners shall prepare for the next Legislature a report on the said preliminary survey, stating the approximate cost of such tramway or wagon road, the number of miles to be built and the probable amount and kind of traffic over such tramway or wagon road if built.

Appropriation.

Section 3. The sum of three thousand (\$3,000.00) dollars is hereby appropriated for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this Act.

Emergency.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately on its passage and approval.
