

Laws of Alaska

CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT

[S. B. 19]

To amend Section 852 Compiled Laws of Alaska by permitting persons to avail themselves of disability which commences after right of action accrues and before the right to commence action expires.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 852 Compiled Laws of Alaska is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

“No person shall avail himself of a disability unless it existed when his right of action accrued OR BEGAN BEFORE THE TIME FOR COMMENCING THE ACTION EXPIRED.”

Disability must exist when right of action accrued and before time for commencement expires.

CHAPTER 2.

AN ACT

[H. B. 2]

To authorize the entertainment of the President of the United States on his visit to Alaska, and to appropriate the money therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the Governor of the Territory is hereby authorized to make all arrangements for the entertainment of the President of the United States upon

his visit here, and to pay for the same the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) or [so] much as may be needed for said purpose, and for that purpose there is hereby appropriated the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) out of the moneys not otherwise appropriated.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 3.

AN ACT

[H. B. 10]

For the appropriation of the sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, (\$4,500.00) for maintenance of the Pioneers Home, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Pioneers' Home
Deficiency,
\$4,500 appro-
priated.

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the Treasury, the sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, for the maintenance of the Pioneers Home, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the quarter ending March 31, 1923.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
