

“(b) The affidavit of the applicant that he has been duly admitted to the practice of law in such court, and that he is in good stand- therein and that there are no charges, affect- ing his professional character, reputation or conduct, pending and undisposed of against him any where;

On affidavit.

such applicant may be admitted to practice law as an attorney and counsellor in this Territory without further examination.”

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## CHAPTER 26.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 17]

To provide a fee to be collected by the Secretary of the Territory of Alaska for issuing certificate with seal of the Territory affixed.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska :

Section 1. For issuing each certificate with Seal of the Territory of Alaska affixed, the Secretary of Alaska shall collect a fee of Two Dollars (\$2.00) for the first three folios, or less, and twenty cents (20c) per folio for each additional folio. All fees received under this section shall be by the Secretary of Alaska accounted for and covered into the Territorial Treasury.

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## CHAPTER 27.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 20]

To amend Section 1558, Chapter 73, Title XIII., of the Compiled Laws of Alaska 1913.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska :

Section 1. That Section 1558, Chapter 73, Title XIII,

of the Compiled Laws of Alaska 1913 be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows:

Commissioner

Seal and Oath  
of office when  
and where filed.

"Section 1558. A commissioner appointed under the last section, shall before he can exercise the powers therein conferred, provide himself with a seal of office, and take and subscribe an oath before a judicial officer in the county, city, or town where he resides, faithfully to perform the duties of the office of a commissioner to take affidavits, depositions, and the proof and acknowledgment of deeds, out of the Territory, according to the laws thereof, and file such oath and an impression of such seal in the office of the Secretary of the Territory. The Secretary of the Territory shall collect five dollars for each certificate of appointment made under this chapter and shall account for and cover the same into the treasury of the Territory of Alaska."

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## CHAPTER 28.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 16]

To provide for the covering of certain fees into the treasury of the Territory of Alaska, and repealing Section 328, Chapter 4, Title IX of the Compiled Laws of Alaska.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. All fees received by officers of the government under Section 327, Chapter 4, Title IX, of the Compiled Laws of Alaska 1913, shall be covered by said officers receiving same into the treasury of the Territory of Alaska.

Sec. 328 Com-  
piled Laws of  
Alaska  
Repealed.

Section 2. That Section 328, Chapter 4, Title IX of the Compiled Laws of Alaska 1913, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. All acts and parts of acts in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
