

making the arrest must take him before the court if in session, unless otherwise ordered by the court; and if the court is not in session, or if the court or judge makes an order so directing, before a commissioner for the purpose of putting in bail; and thereupon such commissioner must proceed in respect thereto according to the provisions of Chapter 22 of this act, entitled 'bail.'"

When defendant must be taken before magistrate.

CHAPTER 32.

AN ACT

[S. B. 61]

To amend Section 660 Compiled Laws of Alaska 1913, relative to foreign corporations doing business in Alaska.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 660 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska 1913 be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 660. If any corporation or company shall fail to comply with any of the provisions of this Chapter, all contracts made by such corporation or company with residents of the Territory of Alaska, made in the Territory, shall be void as to the corporation or company, and no court of the Territory shall enforce the same in favor of the corporation or company."

Penalty for failure to comply.
