

CHAPTER 41.

AN ACT

[S. B. 811]

To amend Section 1300 Compiled Laws of Alaska.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 1300 of the Compiled Laws of the Territory of Alaska, be amended to read as follows:

“Section 1300. When a marriage has been solemnized in the territory an action may be maintained to declare it void if the plaintiff is an inhabitant of the territory at the commencement of the action. If the marriage has not been solemnized in the territory, such action can only be maintained when the plaintiff has been an inhabitant thereof for two years prior to the commencement of an action.”

CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT

[S. B. 511]

To amend Section 1925, Compiled Laws of Alaska, relating to the alteration of earmarks or buttons and brands on animals.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 1925 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska be amended so as to read as follows:

“Section 1925: That if any person shall willfully and knowingly make, alter, or deface any artificial earmark, button or brand upon any horse, mare, gelding, foal, mule, ass, jenny, bull, cow, steer, calf, sheep, swine, goat, reindeer or fox, the property of another, with intent thereby to convert the same to his own use, such

person shall be deemed guilty of larceny and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by imprisonment in the penitentiary not less than one nor more than five years."

CHAPTER 43.

AN ACT

[S. B. 85]

To provide for the time of filing of affidavits of annual labor on mining claims, and repealing all acts and parts of acts in conflict herewith.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The affidavits of annual labor on mining claims, provided for by existing law, shall, in order that the same may be prima facie evidence of the facts therein set forth, be filed for record in the office of the recorder of the precinct in which such claims are situated within ninety days after the close of the yearly period during which such labor now is, or hereafter may be, required to be done by law.

Time for filing affidavit of annual labor on mining claims.

Section 2. All acts and parts of acts in conflict with this act are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

CHAPTER 44.

AN ACT

[H. B. 4]

To amend Section 6 of Chapter 32 of the Laws of 1913 as amended by Section 2 of Chapter 16, Laws of 1917, relative to duties of Board of Children's Guardians.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 6 of Chapter 32, Laws of 1913, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 16, Laws of 1917, be amended so as to read as follows:
