

When wages due.

Section 4. All wages of employees in and around canneries and salteries shall be due and payable monthly and within fifteen (15) days after the last day of the month in which the wages were earned; PROVIDED, however, that when the services are completed or the employee is discharged prior to such pay day the wages or other compensation earned by him shall be paid without delay, but nothing contained herein shall be construed to prohibit the payment of wages at more frequent periods than monthly.

Notices designating regular pay days must be posted by employers.

Section 5. Every employer shall establish and maintain regular pay days as herein provided and shall post and maintain notices, printed or written in plain type or script, in at least two conspicuous places where such notices can be seen by the employees as they go to and from their work, setting forth the regular pay days as herein prescribed. Nothing in this act contained shall be deemed to interfere with any right of contract.

Effective after Jan. 1, 1924.

Section 6. This act shall take effect from and after January 1st, 1924.

CHAPTER 50.

AN ACT

[H. B. 14]

To amend Section 362 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska 1913, relating to bond required of the Secretary of the Territory.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 362 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska 1913 be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

“Section 362. The Secretary of the Territory of Alaska immediately upon the passage and approval of this

act, and each succeeding Secretary of the Territory, before entering upon the duties of his office, shall execute and file with the Treasurer of the Territory an official undertaking with a surety company as surety, which undertaking shall be conditioned upon the faithful performance of the duties of his office, a strict, true and proper accounting of all moneys received by him as such officer, which said bond shall be approved by the Governor of Alaska, be made in favor of the Territory of Alaska and shall be for such sum as shall be fixed by the Governor of Alaska, and shall not be in a sum less than Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars. Provided, further that all premiums on said bond shall be paid by the Territory of Alaska."

CHAPTER 51.

AN ACT

[H. B. 13]

To amend Section 3 of Chapter 22 Session Laws of Alaska 1921, entitled "An Act to prescribe fees and annual tax to be paid by domestic and foreign corporations, and repealing Chapter 11 Session Laws of 1913, as amended by Chapter 54 Session Laws of 1915 and by Chapter 72 Session Laws of 1915."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Chapter 22 of the Session Laws of Alaska 1921 be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. Every corporation incorporated under the provisions of Chapter 12 of the Alaska Session Laws of 1913, entitled, 'An Act to provide for the incorporation of colleges, seminaries, churches, libraries and other benevolent, fraternal, social, religious, educational, charitable or scientific associations, whose chief
