

CHAPTER 71.

AN ACT

[H. B. 46]

To provide for compiling and the safe keeping of a correct list of all Alaskans who actively served in the U. S. Army, Navy or Marine Corps during the World War and appropriating money therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska :

Section 1. The Secretary of Alaska shall compile a correct record of all persons who were bona fide residents of the Territory of Alaska and who actively served in the U. S. Army, Navy or Marine Corps between April 6, 1917 and November 11, 1918, such records to be kept on file at the office of the Secretary of Alaska and shall be available and open to the inspection of anyone desiring to inspect the same. Such record shall contain the name, age and place of residence at the time of entering service, place and date of commission, enlistment or induction, branch of service, record of service and the date, place and nature of discharge.

Section 2. The sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Territory of Alaska for carrying out the provisions of this Act.
