

CHAPTER 75.

AN ACT

[S. B. 92]

To provide that no costs shall be taxed against the defendant in any criminal case or proceeding in any of the Courts of Alaska.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Costs in criminal case not to be taxed against defendant.

Section 1. That no costs shall be taxed to the defendant in any criminal case or proceeding commenced or prosecuted in any of the courts of the Territory of Alaska.

Section 2. All acts and parts of acts in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 76.

AN ACT

[S. B. 103]

To stimulate interest in agricultural development, animal industry, home economics, manufacturing and mining, and providing funds for annual fairs, prescribing rules governing the same, appropriating money therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Territorial aid for fairs.

Section 1. That agricultural and industrial fair associations incorporated under the laws of the Territory of Alaska may receive Territorial aid in conducting and maintaining annual agricultural and industrial fairs as hereinafter provided.

Appropriation, how distributed.

Section 2. That the sum of eight thousand dollars (\$8,000.00) is hereby appropriated out of the moneys in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the aid of agricultural and industrial fair associations within the Territory of Alaska, for conducting

and maintaining annual fairs. One such fair may be held each year in each of the four Judicial Divisions of Alaska; Provided that the people of each Division shall raise and have available for expenditure an equal amount for such fair, and shall have or organize an agricultural and industrial fair association for conducting and maintaining such fair. Provided further that each of said fairs shall be open to entries to the people of the whole Territory, and that special provisions be made for exhibits from the Boys and Girls Clubs.

Entries.

Section 3. The Territorial Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay to each of the agricultural and industrial fair associations entitled to receive the same under the provisions of this act the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) annually.

Yearly limitation of appropriation.

Section 4. Each agricultural and industrial fair association desiring to receive the benefits of this act shall prepare and present to the Governor of the Territory a copy of its articles of incorporation, together with a full program of the proposed fair to be held, and all rules and regulations governing the same, accompanied by a certificate signed by the president and secretary of the association that such association has in its treasury available for expenditure for such proposed fair, the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) contributed by the people of the Division in which such fair is to be held. When satisfied that the association is entitled to receive the benefits of the appropriation provided by this act the Governor shall draw a warrant upon the Treasurer of the Territory to pay the said sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) annually to each association so complying with the provisions of this act, and the Treasurer shall thereupon pay said sums to the association or associations entitled to the benefits hereof. Each association must furnish to the Treasurer of the Territory receipts upon such forms as the Treasurer may prescribe covering the disbursements by said association of all Territorial funds for

Procedure necessary to receive Territorial aid.

any and all fairs held under the provisions of this act.

Emergency.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 77.

AN ACT

[S. B. 115]

For the return of over-paid tax money to the Everett Pacific Fisheries, a corporation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Reimbursement
to Everett
Pacific
Fisheries.

That the sum of one thousand one hundred sixty-eight (\$1,168.00) dollars is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the Territory for the benefit of Everett Pacific Fisheries, a corporation, of Everett, Washington, as a refund for license taxes paid by said corporation to the Territory, under a mistake, for the year 1920, and the Treasurer of the Territory is authorized to pay said sum to the said corporation.

CHAPTER 78.

AN ACT

[S. B. 111]

To make further provisions for the needy and indigent and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not
