CHAPTER 77.

AN ACT

[S. B. 115]

For the return of over-paid tax money to the Everett Pacific Fisheries, a corporation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Reimbursement
to Everett
Pacific
Fisheries.

That the sum of one thousand one hundred sixty-eight (\$1,168.00) dollars is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the Territory for the benefit of Everett Pacific Fisheries, a corporation, of Everett, Washington, as a refund for license taxes paid by said corporation to the Territory, under a mistake, for the year 1920, and the Treasurer of the Territory is authorized to pay said sum to the said corporation.

CHAPTER 78.

AN ACT

[S. B. 111]

To make further provisions for the needy and indigent and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not

otherwise appropriated the sum of Twelve Thousand (\$12,000.00) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used as hereinafter directed for the relief of the needy and indigent of the Territory of Alaska.

Appropriation for needy and indigent.

Section 2. Said money shall be divided for expenditure among the four Judicial Divisions of the Territory of Alaska in proportion to the population of each division as shown by the 1920 census. Not more than six thousand (\$6,000.00) dollars of said money can be expended during the year ending March 1, 1923, [1924] and a like sum during the year ending March 1, 1924. [1925].

How allotted.

Section 3. Said money shall be expended under the direction and upon the approval of the United States District Judges for the several divisions of the Territory of Alaska, and the vouchers for such expenditures shall be signed by the persons to be benefited in such form as may be prescribed by the Territorial Treasurer, and each of said vouchers shall be signed by one of said District Judges in approval thereof.

In what manner expended.

Section 4. Said money shall be used for the relief of the needy and indigent in the Territory of Alaska and may be expended for the purchase of food or clothing or other necessary supplies, for hospital services, medical treatment, transportation, or in such other way as the District Judge may direct for the aid or relief of needy or indigent person.

For what purposes expended.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.
