

CHAPTER 79.

AN ACT

[S. B. 116]

To provide for the procuring and transportation of deer to the Islands of Prince Williams Sound, Kenai Peninsula and adjacent waters and for the procuring and transportation of goats to Baranoff and Chichagof Islands and for the purpose of propagation, and making an appropriation for such purpose, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Habitat of deer
and goats to be
extended.

Section 1. The Governor of Alaska is hereby authorized and it shall be his duty to cause deer to be procured from the islands of Southeastern Alaska, which shall be transported to the Islands of Prince William Sound, Kenai Peninsula and adjacent waters, it shall also be his duty to cause goats to be procured from any part of Alaska where the same can be procured advantageously and cause the same to be transported to Chichagof and Baranoff Islands for the purpose of propagation and food supply.

Appropriation
therefor.

Section 2. The sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) is hereby appropriated out of the moneys in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of this act during the period ending June 1st, 1924.

Same to be
protected.

Section 3. The deer or goats transported or propagated under the provisions of this act shall be the property of the Territory of Alaska, and it shall be unlawful for any person to kill or molest the same at any time within five years after the passage of this act.

Penalty for
violation.

Any persons violating any of the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the Federal Jail for a term of not less than three months nor more than one year.

Section 4. No provisions of this act shall effect the act of Chapter 41, passed in 1917.

Section 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 80.

AN ACT

[S. B. 118]

To authorize the purchase of a cabin for the Kiana School District and making an appropriation therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of two hundred sixty (\$260) dollars is hereby appropriated, or so much thereof as shall be necessary, for the purchase of a cabin to be used as a residence for the teacher of the Kiana School District, said sum to be expended under the direction of the Commissioner of Education with the approval of the Governor.

CHAPTER 81.

AN ACT

[S. B. 114]

For the return of over-paid tax moneys to Standard Oil Company, a corporation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That whereas the Standard Oil Company in 1920 erroneously paid as mercantile license tax for the year 1919 the sum of one thousand one hundred
