

CHAPTER 83.

AN ACT

[S. B. 119]

To authorize substitution of defendants in certain suits against public officers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. A suit to enjoin a public officer from enforcing a statute, or to compel him to act by mandamus, shall not abate upon the defendant's death or retirement from office but the succeeding officer may be substituted as defendant.

CHAPTER 84.

AN ACT

[S. B. 86]

To appropriate funds for the erection of a school house at Haines, Alaska.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Three thousand five hundred (\$3,500) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated for the erection of a public school building in the city of Haines, Alaska.

Section 2. The sum appropriated in Section 1 of this Act shall be expended under the direction of the Commissioner of Education, and shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory upon warrants drawn upon the Treasurer by the Commissioner of Education, specifying the purpose for which such warrants are drawn. Such warrants shall be payable to the Treasurer of the School Board of the City of Haines, Alaska.

Section 3. The monies appropriated by Section 1 of this Act shall become available for the purposes herein

How expended.

stated whenever the City Council of the City of Haines shall have appropriated for the erection of a school building in said city a sum of not less than two thousand (\$2,000) dollars. When such appropriation is made by the said City Council of Haines the Commissioner of Education shall add to such appropriation an equal amount from the appropriation made by this Act, and the same shall be the case as to any further appropriations made by said City of Haines up to a total of \$3500.00, so that when the school house is completed one-half of its cost shall have been paid by the City of Haines and the other half shall have been paid by the Territory of Alaska.

When available and under what conditions.

Section 4. The school building so to be erected shall at all times be available for the education of children who reside at Chilkoot Barracks.

CHAPTER 85.

AN ACT

[H. B. 41]

To regulate the operation of Motor Vehicles upon the public highway outside of incorporated cities within the Territory of Alaska and providing for a penalty for the violation of its provisions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful to operate upon any highway within the Territory of Alaska, any motor vehicle not equipped with a foot brake, emergency brake and horn that can be heard a reasonable distance away; and suitable head lights and tail lights during all the year except during the summer period when there may be no darkness; all of which said appliances must be in good working order and kept up at all times in a state of repair except as to the lights during the above specified summer period when there may be no darkness.
