

House Concurrent Resolutions

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1.

RESOLVED, that the Territorial Legislature of Alaska, in sixth biennial session assembled, extends greetings to Warren G. Harding, President of the United States, and, cordially appreciative of his intended visit to the Territory, pledges to him a warm and patriotic welcome, and, for and on behalf of the people of Alaska, now most heartily renews the invitation tendered by the Legislature of 1921, and earnestly expresses the hope that the visitation will be made as planned, believing that it will be of great and enduring benefit to the Northland.

RESOLVED, further, that a copy of this resolution be telegraphed to the President.

Passed by the Senate, March 10, 1923.

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 2.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring, that the Standing Committee on Printing and Purchasing be instructed to meet with Printing and Purchasing Committee of the Senate to serve as a Joint Committee on Printing and Purchasing.

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Territorial Legislature of Alaska, the Senate concurring; that the Speaker of the House and the President of the Senate appoint a Committee of three members each to confer with the American Legion and the Governor of the Territory of Alaska relative to making arrangements for the presentation of a Distinguished Service Medal to Major Gotwals with such honor and dignity as such event is entitled.
